GAMBIA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION VISITS PARLAIMENT

A seven man delegation from the Gambian Public Service Commission, led by its Chairman, Gabriel Bright, has in a courtesy call on the Leadership of the Sierra Leone Parliament, discussed issues around the development of the Association of Public Service Commissions in Africa and how Sierra Leone in particular is doing with its Public Service Commission.
