

NEW MP REPLACES SPEAKER

The newly elected Member of Parliament for Constituency 100, Mohamed Jawara Kamara, today took the oath of office and was duly sworn in by the Clerk of parliament, completing the number of MPs to 124. He succeeds Hon. S.B.B Dumbuya who was early this year elected Speaker of the Sierra Leone Parliament.
