CAPS CONTINUES TO VET PRESIDENTIAL NOMINEES

The Parliamentary Committee on Appointments and the Public Service (CAPS) has continued for the second successive day to scrutinize and determine the suitability of Presidential nominees to serve the State. In this vein, CAPS has successfully interviewed 10 (ten) Presidential nominees on Thursday 31st March, 2016.

The nominees were interviewed based on their curriculum vitae, experience, track records in various work situations, qualifications, and visionary tenure.

The following Presidential nominees were successfully interviewed by CAPS:

The interviews were openly conducted in the eyes and ears of the general public that were in attendance.

These nominees are subject to the approval of Parliament if the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service adjudges them to be suitably qualified for the positions to which they have been nominated by His Excellency, Dr. Ernest Bai Koroma, President of the Republic of Sierra Leone.
