PC BAI KURR CALLS FOR INVESTIGATION INTO EBOLA RESURGENCE

Parliament has continued its debate on a motion of thanks to HE the President for the Address delivered at the State Opening of the Fourth Session of the Fourth Parliament of the Second Republic of Sierra Leone, last December.

Paramount Chief Bai Kurr Kanagbaro Sanka III, condemned the resurgence of Ebola in Tonkolili, describing it as an unfortunate situation. He called for further investigation into the matter. Also making his submission, the chairman of Transport and Aviation Committee, Hon. Babatunde Lewally, acknowledged the challenges and achievements of the President during the Ebola fight and commended him for transforming the economy during the challenging period of the Ebola war.

For his part, Hon. Frank Kposowa, recognized the special talent of the Minister of Finance for upholding the stability of the economy during the devastating time of the Ebola virus outbreak, whilst commending the RSLAF and Medical Officers for their role in the fight against the virus. He said before the outbreak, the Tourism sector was booming and urged government to boost the industry, it being a critical part of the Pillars of the Agenda for Prosperity.

Hon. Veronica Kadie Sesay, appreciated the pronouncement of the President in his speech, for the Shenge road construction in the Moyamba District. She however frowned at destructive activities of youths, based on what she called diabolical behaviors in the society.

In thanking the President, Hon.Ibrahim Ben Kargo congratulated President Koroma and all Sierra Leoneans for engaging in the fight against the Ebola virus .He also noted the critical role of the National Revenue Authority in providing funds for the running of the State, whilst calling on government to pay more attention to the Tourism sector with its great potentials for socio-economic success.
