Parliament Approves Five Presidential Nominees

Parliament of Sierra Leone on Tuesday 10th November, 2015 adopted the Twenty Second Report of the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service, approving five presidential nominees to serve some public institutions in the country.

These presidential nominees were approved through a collection of voices:

Mr. Raymond Nathaniel Smith - Chairman, National Conservation Trust Fund (NCTF)

Mr. Brima Koroma – Chairman, Sierra Leone Postal Services (SALOPST)

Mr. Emile Adeotie Lasite - Board Member, National Public Procurement Authority

Mr. Tapsiru Lamin Dainkeh - Board Member, SALHOC and

Ing. Gertrude Sara Trudy Morgan, Member, National Commission for Privatization

These approved nominees had been interviewed by the Committee on Appointments and Public Service.
