

Amendment
of Act No. 12
of 2008.

The Anti-Corruption Act, 2008 is amended by the repeal and replacement of subsections 1 and 2 of section 119 by the following subsections:—

“Public officers
to declare assets
and liabilities.

119 (1) Every public officer shall within three months of becoming a public officer and while leaving office deposit with the Commission a sworn declaration of his income, assets and liabilities.

(2) Every person who at the commencement of this Act is a public officer shall within three months of the commencement of this Act and after leaving office deposit with the Commission a sworn declaration of his income, assets and liabilities”.
