Interpretation. Act No. 1 of 1992. 2. For the purposes of this Act and notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 of the Public Budgeting and Accounting Act, 1992, "fiscal year" means the period extending from the 17th day of February, 1998 to the 31st day of December, 1998.

The amount from time to time paid for and in respect of the expenditure authorised in section 5 shall not exceed in the gross the sum of one hundred and sixty-two billion, four hundred and twenty million, seven hundred and eighty-two thousand, seventy-two leones from the seventeenth day of February, Nineteen Hundred and Ninety-eight inclusive, and any balances remaining unissued at the end of December, Nineteen Hundred and Ninety-eight shall lapse and not be available for making any payment in the following year.
