

Amendment  
of section 38  
of Act No. 6  
of 1991.

1. The Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991 is amended in section 38, by the repeal and replacement of subsection (8), by the following new subsection-

“(8) The registration of voters and the conduct of elections in every constituency shall be subject to the direction and supervision of the Electoral Commission, and it shall cause the register of voters to be revised or reviewed at least once in every three years:

Provided that where the register of voters has not been revised or reviewed in accordance with this subsection, bye-elections shall be conducted using the existing register of voters.”

Passed in Parliament this *17th day of May*, in the year of our Lord two thousand and sixteen.
