1. Section 5 of the Citizenship Act, 1973 is repealed and replaced by the following new section—

“Citizenship  
by descent

5. Every person born outside Sierra Leone on or after the nineteenth day of April 1971 of a father or mother who was or would but for the death of the person have been a citizen of Sierra Leone by virtue of sections 2, 3 and 4, is a citizen of Sierra Leone by birth.”

#### MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to amend section 5 of the Citizenship Act, 1973 to take into cognizance the amendment made to the Citizenship Act in 2006 wherein citizenship by birth can now be granted directly through the mother. This new clause proposes the insertion of the word “mother” to take into consideration the 2006 amendment.
