The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 2022 Short title.

Being an Act to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 76 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991

ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled.

Amendment
of section 76
(1) (a) of Act
No. 6 of 1991.

1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 76 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991 (Act No. 6 of 1991) is amended by repealing and replacing that paragraph with the following new paragraph-

"(a) if he is a naturalised citizen of Sierra Leone;"

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of the Bill is to amend the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991 to provide for the removal of the disqualification of a person to be elected a Member of Parliament on the grounds that he is a citizen of a country other than Sierra Leone and to provide for other related matters.
