MARRAY CONTEH: Mr Speaker, Honourable Members I present the fifth report of the Legislative Committee of the fourth session of the fifth Parliament of the Second Republic of Sierra Leone on the Bill entitled: The National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act 202, presented to Parliament on Tuesday the 8th February 2022.

Mr Chairman, Honourable Members I rise to present the fifth report of the legislative committee fourth session of the fifth parliament of the second republic of Sierra Leone on the Bill entitled: **'THE NATIONAL PROTECTED AREA AUTHORITY AND**

CONSERVATION TRUST FUND ACT, 2021" being an Act to amend the National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act 2012, and to provide for other related matters. Mr Chairman, Honourable Members, the Bill having gone through the second reading was committed to the legislative committee for scrutiny pursuant to Standing Orders 51 [1]. Subsequently, the committee met on Thursday 24th February, 2022 in the Committee Room 1 of Parliament building for the following objectives to scrutinize in details the principles and provisions of the Bill and to make amendments if necessary. To ascertain [*interruption*].

B. THE NATIONAL PROTECTED AREA AUTHORITY AND CONSERVATION TRUST FUND ACT 2021.

COMMITTEE STAGE AND THIRD READING.

The House resolves into Committee of the whole House.

HON. ABDUL S. MARRAY CONTEH: Mr Chairman, Honourable Members I rise to present the fifth report of the legislative committee, fourth session of the fifth Parliament of the second Republic of Sierra Leone on the Bill entitled: **'The National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act 2021''**, being an Act to amend the National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2012 and to provide for other related matters. Mr Chairman, Honourable Members the Bill having gone through second reading was committed to the Legislative Committee for scrutiny first round to Standing Orders 51[1]. Subsequently, the Committee met on Thursday 24th February, 2022 in Committee Room Number one of Parliament building with the following objectives: To scrutinise in detail the principles and provisions of the Bill and to make amendment if necessary. To ascertain the Constitutional and legal implications contain therein. To report preliminary for consideration by the Committee of the whole House in line with SO [53]. Mr Chairman, Honourable Members in attendance as well, the Minister of Environment, Deputy Minister of Environment, the Chairman of the Legislative Committee, Members of the Legislative Committee and other Members of Parliament. Mr Chairman, Honourable members, the Legislative Committee having scrutinised the Bill line by line, and Clause by Clause recommends the following amendments to the House for approval:

1. The short title being amended by changing the year 2021 to 2022. To now read, National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2022.

The long title of the Bill be approved. Part one preliminary, Clause 1 interpretations that the word "Minister" be amended by inserting the phrase "*responsible for"* immediately after the word "*Minister"* and deleting the word "*of"*. To now read, Minister means; the Minister responsible for the environment. Part two National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund. Clause 2 continuation of National Protected Area Authority. The side note of Clause 2 be amended by inserting the phrase "*of the national"* immediately after the word "*continuation"*. To now read, continuation of the National Protected Area Authority. Clause 3 sub clause 2, board of authority. [**D**] Be amended by replacing "*Ministry of Finance"* with "*National Disaster Management Agency"*. [**H**] Be amended by replacing "*ministry of planning and economic development"* with "*office of National Security"*. And [**M**] Be amended by replacing the phrase "*Njala University College"* with the phrase "*in reputable university institution in Sierra Leone"*. To now read, environmental

sciences department in reputable university institution in Sierra Leone. Clause 4 Tenure of Members be approved. Clause 5 sub clause [1] meetings of board be amended by replacing the figure "*two*" with the figure "*three*". To now read, the board shall meet for the dispatch of its business at least once every three months and at such time as the Chairman may determine. Clause 5 sub clause [3] meetings of Board be amended by replacing the figure "three" with the figure "five". Clause 6 Disclosure of interest be approved. Clause 7 sub clause [1] Immunity of Members be amended by deleting the phrase "in good faith" immediately after the word "done". To now read, an action or other proceedings shall not lie or be instituted against a member of the board or member of a committee of the board for or in respect of an act or thing done or omitted to be done in the exercise of his functions under this Act. Clause 8 Committees of Board be approved. Clause 9 Functions of Board be approved. Clause 10 Remunerations of Members be amended by inserting the word "sitting" before the word "fees". To now read, the Chairman and other members of the board and the person co-opted by the board under sub section eight of section five shall be paid such remuneration, sitting fees and allowances approve by the Minister and shall be reimbursed by the authority for expenses incur in connection with the discharge of their functions as the board may with the approve of the Minister determine subject to the approval of Parliament. Clause 11 Filling of Vacancies be approved. Part three Functions of the Authority be amended by inserting the word "*the*" after the word "*functions*". To now read, functions of the authority. Clause 12 Functions of the Authority side note of Clause 12 be amended by inserting the Phrase "of the" after the word "functions". To now read, functions of the authority. Clause 12 sub clause [1] functions of the authority be amended by deleting the phrase "an environmental management". To now read, the object for which the authorities established, is to exercise oversight authority over national parks and protected areas designated for conservation purposes so as to protect the fanner and flora in his natural state promote sustainable land use practice. Clause 12 sub clause 2 [A] Functions of the Authority be amended by replacing the phrase "in Sierra Leone" with the phrase "within designated national parks and protected areas". To now read, ensure the protection of natural

ecosystems and threaten bio-diversity within designated national parks and protected areas including the establishment and maintenance of representative and sustainable samples. Clause 12 sub clause 2 [B] Functions of the Authority be amended by replacing the phrase "throughout Sierra Leone" with the phrase "within designated national parks and protected areas". To now read; oversee the management of local and private nature reserves and sanctuaries within designated national parks and protected areas including zoos and wildlife rescue and rehabilitation centres. Clause 12 sub Clause 2[C] Functions of the Authority be deleted. Clause 12 sub Clause 2[D] Functions of the Authority be amended by replacing the phrase "throughout Sierra Leone" with the phrase "within designated national parks and protected areas". To now read, regulate wildlife conservation and management within designated national parks and protected areas in accordance with the wildlife conservation act, 1972 act No 27 of 1972. Clause 12 sub clause 2[G] Functions of the Authority be amended by replacing the phrase "throughout Sierra Leone" with the phrase "on national protected areas". To now read, develop and implement wildlife conservation, education and training programs on national protected areas. Clause 12 sub clause 2[K] Functions of the Authority be deleted.

Clause 12 sub clause 2[M] Functions of the Authority be deleted. Clause 12 sub clause 2[N] functions of the authority be amended by inserting the phrase "*within designated national parks and protected areas*" immediately after the word "*flora*". To now read, prepare detail inventory and mapping of fanner and flora within designated national parks and protected areas. Clause 12 sub clause 2[O] Functions of the Authority be amended by replacing the phrase "*in Sierra Leone*" with the phrase "*within designated national parks and protected areas*. Clause 12 sub clause 2[O] Functions of the Authority be amended by replacing the phrase "*in Sierra Leone*" with the phrase "*within designated national parks and protected areas*". To now read, established a detail by diversity monitory program including a geographic information system unit that will store and disseminate data on the status of bio-diversity within designated national parks and protected areas. Clause 12 sub clause 2[P] Functions of the Authority be amended by deleting roman figure "*i, ii, iii, IV, v, VI, viii, x, and xiii*". Roman figure vii now becomes the new one, ix becomes the new two, xi becomes

the new three and xii becomes the new four. Clause 12 sub clause 2[P] roman figure iii previously roman figure xi, functions of the authority be amended by replacing the phrase "inside and outside national" with the phrase "within designated national packs and protected areas. To now read, promoting policies for enabling by local forest edge communication to participate and co-manage national resources within designated national packs and protected areas. Part four Administrative Provisions. Clause 13 Appointment of Executive Director side note of clause 13 be amended by inserting the word "of" after the word "appointment". To now read, Appointment of Executive Director. Clause 13 sub Clause [1] Appointment of Executive Director be amended by deleting the word "of" after the word "be", and replacing the phrase "board upon" such terms and conditions as the board shall after consultation with the *Minister determine"* with the phrase "by the President on the recommendation of the Minister subject to the approval of Parliament". To now read, the authority shall have an Executive Director who shall be appointed by the President on the recommendation of the Minister subject to the approval of Parliament. Clause 13 sub Clause [2] Appointment of Executive Director be amended by deleting the phrase "protection and bio-diversity conservation" and inserting the word "issues" immediately after the word "environmental". To now read, a person shall not be appointed an Executive Director unless he has proven knowledge in forest management and experience in environmental issues. Clause 14 Functions of Executive Director be amended by inserting a new "E". To read, serve as secretary to the board and for every meeting of the board keep minute of proceedings of the meeting previously "E" now becomes "F". A new clause 15 be inserted with a new side note to read deputy Executive Director. New clause 15 sub Clause [1], Deputy Executive Director be amended by inserting a new sub Clause [1]. To read, the Executive Director shall be assisted by a Deputy Executive Director who shall be appointed by the board on such terms and conditions as the board may determine. New Clause 15 sub Clause [2] Deputy Executive Director be amended by inserting a new sub Clause [2]. To read, a person shall not be appointed a Deputy Executive Director unless he has proven knowledge in forest management and experience in environmental issues. Clause 15 be

amended by renumbering it to become Clause 16. Clause 16 sub Clause [1], previously Clause 15 sub Clause [1], other staff of authority be amended by deleting the word "secretary" after the letter "A" and before the word "finance". To now read, the authority shall have in addition to the Executive Director a secretariat consisting of a finance officer, administrative officer and such other additional technical administrative staff as maybe required for the efficient performance of the functions of the authority. Clause 16 sub Clause [2] previously Clause 15 sub Clause [2], other staff of authority be amended by deleting the word "secretary" and "the" after the word "the" and before the word "other". To now read, the other staff of the authority shall be appointed by the board subject to such terms and conditions as the board shall determine. Clause 16 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 17. Clause 17 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 18. Clause 18 sub Clause 2[B] previously Clause 17 sub Clause 2[B], Department of Authority be amended by deleting the phrase "community conservation" and the phrase "and co-management". To now read, outreach. Clause 18 sub clause [3] previously Clause 17 sub clause [3], department of authority be deleted. Clause 18 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 19. Clause 19 previously Clause 18, Protection of offices side note of Clause 19 previously Clause 18, be amended by replacing the word "*protection*" with the word "immunity". To now read, immunity of offices. Clause 19 previously Clause 18, Protection of officers be amended by deleting the phrase "in good faith" immediately after the word "him". To now read, an officer or employee of the authority or a person acting on the directions of the board shall not be liable in respect of any matter or thing done by him under this Act. Part five Conservation Trust Fund. Clause 19 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 20. Previously Clause 20 Objective of Trust be deleted. Clause 21 Functions of Trust remains as Clause 21. Clause 22 Powers of Trust be deleted. Clause 23 now becomes the new Clause 22. Clause 22 previously Clause 23, Corporation between trust and authority be amended by replacing the letters "R and O" with the letters "O and E" before and after the letter "P" respectively in the word "corporation". To now read, corporation and deleting the word "and" after the word "funding". To now read, the trust shall

establish and maintain with the authority collaboration and corporation mechanisms for the purpose of funding bio-diversity protection and enhancement activities. Clause 24 be amended by renumbering it to become clause 23. Clause 23 sub clause [1] previously Clause 24 sub clause [1]: Administration of Trust be amended by deleting the phrase "not less than five" and replacing it with the phrase "four other". To now read, the trust shall be administered by a board of trustees consisting of a chairman, and four other members appointed by the Minister by notice published in the gazette. Clause 23 sub clause [2] previously Clause 24 sub clause [2] administration of trust, be amended by inserting the phrase "of the authority" after the word "board". To now read, the President shall appoint one member of the board of the authority as Chairman of the board of trustee after consultation with the Minister subject to the approval of Parliament. Clause 25 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 24. Clause 24 previously Clause 25 Trust to be body corporate side note of Clause 24 previously Clause 25, be amended by inserting the word "the' before the word "trust". To now read, the trust to be body corporate. Clause 26 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 25. Clause 25 previously Clause 26 Forms of Trust. Side note of Clause 25 previously Clause 26 be amended by inserting the word "the" before the word "trust". To now read, forms of the trust. Clause 25 sub clause [1] previously Clause 26 sub clause [1] Forms of trust be amended by deleting "C and D". Clause 27 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 26. Clause 28 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 27. Clause 29 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 28. Part six the National Protected Area. Clause 30 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 29. Part seven Miscellaneous Provisions. Clause 31 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 30. Clause 30 sub clause 2[B] previously Clause 31 sub clause 2[B] regulations, be amended by deleting the letter "S" from the word "applications". To read, application. Clause 30 sub clause 2[D] previously Clause 31 sub clause 2[D] regulations, be amended by deleting the word "*part*" after the word "or". To now read, the control of persons or animals (including domestic animals) in the National Protected Areas or any parts thereof either permanently or temporally. Clause 30, sub clause 2[E], previously Clause 31 sub clause 2[E]

regulations, be amended by spacing the word "or" from the word "regulations". To now read, the prohibition, restriction, control or regulation of burning of vegetation or the cutting, felling or removal of timber in or from the National Protected Area or any part thereof. Clause 30 sub clause 2[G] previously Clause 31 sub clause 2[G] regulations, be amended by deleting the word "part" after the word "or". To now read, the prohibition, restriction, control or regulation of the possession or use of weapons in the National Protected Area or any part thereof. Clause 30, sub clause 2[H], previously Clause 31 sub clause 2[H] regulations, be amended by deleting the word "part" after the word "or". To now read, the fees to be paid if any by persons entering in the National Protected Area or any part thereof or to be paid in respect of the doing of any specified act therein or the use of any article or facility therein. Clause 30, sub clause 2[M], previously Clause 31 sub clause 2[M] regulations, be amended by inserting the phrase "endangers species and other" immediately after the word "snakes" and deleting the word "and" after the word "crocodile". To now read, the destruction of the eggs of crocodile, poisonous snakes and other endanger species in the national protected area or any part thereof. Clause 32 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 31. Clause 31 previously Clause 32 penalty, side note of Clause 31 previously Clause 32, be amended by deleting the letter "I" after the letter "L" in the word "penality". To now read, penalty. Clause 31 previously Clause 32 penalty, be amended by replacing the word "*exceeding*" with the phrase "*less than*" and replacing the figures "25MLN" with the figures of "15MLN". And replacing figure "5" with the figure "2". To now read, a person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Act, commits an offence and he is liable on conviction to a fine not less than fifteen million to imprisonment for a term not less than two years or to both such fine and imprisonment and may also be liable to different penalties in case of successive breaches of or continuous breaches. Clause 33 be amended by renumbering it to become Clause 32. Conclusion, Mr Chairman, Honourable Members, the Legislative Committee having scrutinised the Bill entitled the National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2021 recommend these proposals to the House for approval. The reports reflect the consensus of Honourable Members of the Committee.

I therefore move that with this amendment the House pass the Bill entitle the National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2021 through Committee stage, third reading and into Law. HON. ABDUL S. MARRAY CONTEH Sixth report of the Legislative Committee, fourth session of the fifth Parliament on the second Republic of Sierra Leone on the Bill

entitled the Environment Protection Agency Act 2021, presented to Parliament on Tuesday 2nd November 2021.

Introduction: Mr Chairman, Honourable Members, I rise to present the sixth report of the Legislative Committee forth session of the fifth Parliament of the second Republic of Sierra Leone on the Bill entitled the Environment Protection Agency Act 2021, being an Act to provide for the continuation of the Sierra Leone Environment Protection Agency to provide for more effective and efficient protection and management of the environment and to provide for other related matters. Mr Chairman, Honourable Members, the Bill having gone through the second reading was committed to the Legislative Committee for scrutiny pursuant to Standing Order 51(1). Subsequently, the Committee met on Thursday 23rd and Monday 29th November 2021 in the Committee Room 1 of the Parliament building with the following objectives; To scrutinize in detail, the principles and provisions of the Bill and to make amendment if necessary; To ascertain the Constitutional and legal implications contain therein; To report to plenary for consideration by the Committee of the whole House in line with SO 53.

Mr Chairman, Honourable Members, in attendance were members of the Legislative Committee, the Chairman of the Environment Committee other interested members of Parliament, the Minister of Environment, the Deputy Minister of Environment, the Permanent Secretary Ministry of Environment and other senior members of the Ministry.

Recommendations: Mr Chairman, Honourable Members, the Legislative Committee, having scrutinized the Bill line by line and Clause by Clause recommends the following amendments to the House for approval. The short title, Environment Protection Agency Act 2022 be approved. The long title of the Bill, being an Act to provide for the continuation of the Sierra Leone Environment Protection Agency to provide for more effective and efficient protection and management of the environment and to provide for the other related matters be approved.

Part one, Preliminary, Clause 1 *Interpretation*, the definition of Agency be amended by deleting the phrase *'Sierra Leone"* after the word *"the"* and before the word *"environment"* and inserting the phrase *"in Sierra Leone"* after the word *"agency"*

and before the word "referred" to now read, "Agency means, the Environment Protection Agency in Sierra Leone referred to in section two." Clause 1, Interpretation, the definition of controlled substance be amended by inserting the phrase "hydro chlorofluorocarbons, HCFC after the word "*virgins"* and before the word "*recovered*" to now read, "controlled substance includes chlorofluorocarbons other fully halogenated chlorofluorocarbons, harlon, carbon, tetrachloride 111, trichlorothine, methylle, bromade, whether they are virgin hydro fluorocarbon HAFCs and other Hydrofluorocarbons HAFCs recovered and recycled or reclaimed but do not include any controlled substance." Clause 1, Interpretation be amended by deleting the entire definition of national Tele Communication Commission. Clause 1, Interpretation be amended by inserting the definition of "permit" after the definition of "Paris Agreement" and before the definition of "Petroleum Regulatory Agency" to read, "permit means, a permit granted by the Agency in accordance with the Act or the Regulations made there under." Clause 1, Interpretation, the definition of "Pollution" be amended by inserting the pronoun "*it*" after the word "*that*" and before the word "*is",* and also inserting the phrase "*and human health"* after the word "environment" and before the word "or" to now read, "Pollution means, natural man made or man aided alteration of the chemical or biological quality of the chemical, physical or biological quality of the environment to the extent that it is detrimental to the environment and human health or beyond acceptable limit." Clause 1 Interpretation be amended by inserting a definition of 'Wet Lands" after the definition of 'Waters of Sierra Leone" to read, "Wet Land means, areas permanently or seasonally flooded by water where plants and animals have adapted."

Part two, Continuation of Environmental Protection Agency. - B. Entitle the holder to only import or export the controlled substance or controlled product specified in the permit only through authorised custom port of entry and exit.
- C. Expires on the 31st day of December of the year of issue and all import relating to the permit shall arrive at the port of entry in Sierra Leone not later than 31st day of December of that year.

Clause 48, storage of controlled substances or controlled product be amended to now become clause 47. New clause 47, storage of controlled substances or controlled products sub clause 3, to be amended by deleting the word "under" after the word "product" and before the word "in" to now read, "the person who stores controlled substances or controlled

product in contravention of the guidelines issued by the agency under sub section 2, commits an offence and is liable on conviction in the case of." New clause 47, storage of controlled substances or controlled product sub clause 38 to be amended replacing the words "*the natural person*" with the words "*an individual*" at the beginning of the sentence and also reducing the term of imprisonment from five years to three years, to now read, "an individual to fine of not less than fifty million Leones or to imprisonment for a term not less than three years and."

New clause 47, storage of controlled substances or controlled products, sub clause 3(b) to be amended by increasing the fine from one hundred million to five hundred million Leones to now read, "a body cooperate to a fine not less than five hundred million Leones."

Clause 57, certificate of analysis and its effect to be amended to now become clause 52. New clause 52, certificate of analysis and its effect to be approved. Clause 58, records to be kept to be amended to now become clause 53. New clause 38 to be amended by replacing words "*the natural person"* with the words "*an individual"* and also inserting the words "*or to such fine and imprisonment"* after the word "*years"* and before the word "*and"* to now read "an individual to a fine of not less than fifty million Leones or to imprisonment for a term of not less than two years or to such fines and imprisonment and." New clause 53, records to be kept, sub clause 3(b) to be amended by increasing the fine from Hundred million Leones to Two hundred and Fifty million Leones."

Part ten, Information and Education and Public Awareness to be amended to now become part nine. New part nine Information, Education and Public Awareness to be approved. Clause 59, Freedom of Access to Information to be amended to now become clause 54. New clause 54, Freedom of Access to Information to be approved.

Clause 60, Gathering Analysis and Management of Information to be amended to now become clause 55. New clause 55, Gathering Analysis and Management of Information

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sub clause 3 to be amended by replacing the word "*state*" with the word "*countries*" after the word "*other*" at the end of the paragraph, to now read, "the agency shall determine deficiencies in existing environment information and exchange information with other persons including international organisation, non-governmental organisations and governmental agencies of other countries."

Clause 61, Environment Education and Learning Institutions to be amended to now become clause 56. New clause 56, Environment Education and Learning Intuitions to be approved.

Part Eleven, Judicial Proceedings to be amended to now become part ten. New part ten, judicial proceedings to be approved. Clause 62, Institution of Criminal Proceedings to be amended to now become clause 57. New clause 57, institution of criminal proceedings be approved. Clause 63, institution of civil proceeding, to be amended to now become clause 58. New clause 58, institution of civil proceedings to be approved. Clause 64, enforcement notice to be amended to now become clause 59. New clause 59, enforcement notice, side notes to be amended by inserting "*power of the agency relating to*" before the word "*enforcement*" at the beginning. Side note to now read, "*Power of the agency relating to enforcement notice.*"

New clause 59, Power of the agency relating to enforcement notice, sub clause 4 to be amended by inserting the words "*commit an offence and*" after the number (2) and before the word "*is*" to now read, "a person who fails to comply with an enforcement notice served to him under sub section 1 commit an offence and is liable to a fine not less than two hundred and fifty million Leones." Clause 65 immunity of officers to be expunged. Clauses 66, liability of bodies cooperate etc., to be amended to now become clause 60. New clause 60, liability of bodies corporate etc., sub clause 3 to be amended by inserting the word "*or*", after the word "him" and before the word "*on*", to now read, "a person is personally liable for an offence under this act, whether committed by him or on his own account or as an agent or servant of another person." Clause 68, effect of conviction to be amended to now become clause 62. New clause 62, effect of conviction to be approved. Clause 69, financial security, to be amended to now become clause 63. New clause 63, financial security to be approved.

Part 11, judicial proceedings to be amended to now become part 10, and approved after renumbering. Part 12, environment coordination committee to be amended to now become, part 11 and be approved after renumbering and replacing the phrase **"Executive Director"** with the phrase **"Executive Chairman"** wherever it appears in this path. Part 13, miscellaneous provisions to be amended to now become part 12, and be approved after renumbering the phrase **"Executive Director"** with the phrase **"Executive Chairman"** wherever it appears in this path. Part 13, miscellaneous provisions to be amended to now become part 12, and be approved after renumbering and replacing the phrase **"Executive Director"** with the phrase **"Executive Chairman"** wherever it appears in this path. The first to the fifth schedules to be approved.

Conclusion, Mr Chairman, Honourable members, the legislative committee having scrutinized the Bill entitled the Environment Protection Agency Act 2021, recommends these proposals to the House for approval. The report reflects the consensus of Honourable Members of the Committee. I therefore move that, with these amendments the House pass this bill entitled the environment protection act 2021, through committee stage third reading and into law. Thank you for your attention. [Undertones] I beg your pardon; [undertones] take note of what I have said. Take due note of what I have said and convey it wherever you wish to convey it, but we must express our wholesome, fulsome appreciation to the Honourable Member. This job is very laborious, very tedious. You have done remarkably well Youngman and this house will continue to need your services in the foreseeable future. I will now entertain a motion from the Deputy Leader of Government Business. Mr Minister when you come here we are in charge.

HON. BASHIRU SILIKIE Mr Speaker, Honourable Members, I stand on SO 37. Mr Speaker, Honourable members, I move that we postpone the question put to the next sitting as have been read by the report of the committee on the legislative affairs. Thank you very much.

Me Speaker, Honourable Members, I am just coming from Bo, of course my constituency, and Mr Speaker Honourable members, I participated in March 18, the international women's day celebrations. I was one of the speakers, and particularly a keynote speaker, and the women of Bo district asked that I must convey their voice to this House through you and perhaps for the attention of our president who is not here now, but I should convey this message to this House through you that they have a communiqué and that communiqué is in respect of the Bill that is in this Well of Parliament that is yet to be debated. That is the Gender Empowerment Bill. It is a communiqué, don't laugh, and I must speak on their behalf. So Mr Speaker, Honourable Members, I have the communiqué here with me which I will at the end of the day give to the President of the Female Caucus. The women of Bo district want their voice to be added to the bill which I shall be given to the President of Female Caucus that they want this communiqué which I have at hand, it to go through this House and they want to add their voices through me that they support that Bill that the Minister has already laid in this well of parliament. Thank you.

THE SPEAKER: I thank the Honourable Member.

HON. P.C. BAI KURR KANAGBARO SANKA III: Mr Speaker Sir, I stand on SO 23.

THE SPEAKER: Go ahead.

HON. P C. BAI KURR KANAGBARO III: Mr Speaker, Honourable Members of parliament, I know very well that all of us are aware of what is going on in the world, particularly in Ukraine. I am just a little bit worried whether we have Sierra Leoneans there or whether we have students there and what have we done together with other countries who are taken their students or citizens out of Ukraine.

THE SPEAKER: Chief will you like to address a written question to the Minister of Foreign Affairs.

HON. P.C. BAI KURR KANAGBARO SANKA III: I will sir.

THE SPEAKER: I think it is an appropriate question for him to illicit information from our Embassy in Moscow.

HON. P.C. BAI KURR KANAGBARO SANKA III: I will sir. You will help me to draft it Sir [undertone]

THE SPEAKER: Yes,

HON. DANIEL B. KOROMA: Mr Speaker it's just in line with the submission of the Honourable Member from Bo. I will advise her that we cannot be operating in the dark. So let her ensure that the communiqué is delivered to all MPs so we will be preview to the content of the communiqué and then that will empower us or inform us better to support, rather than just informing us that there is a communiqué. Let us be served.

HON. NENEH LEBBIE: Consider it done. Through my leadership, I am waiting for her.

THE SPEAKER: I think I should add in consonance with what the Honourable Member has just said that I addressed the Executive Committee of the CPA, Africa Region on the 8th March, 2022 in Accra on this particular subject and made a copy of my address available. I think if you look at the social media or other news outlets you will be able to see what I have to say not specifically on the Bill, but generally on the question of empowering women, and I believe instead of Parliament all the time looking to the Executive to empower, I believe that charity should begin at home. Parliament itself should begin the process of empowering women within its own institution. And let nobody tell me there are cultural practices against it. Where there is a strong will, there is a way.

HON. ALUSINE KANNEH: Mr Speaker, one thing I like you for, you just mentioned that charity begins at home and then the speakership, we are going to start with the speakership.

THE SPEAKER: No problem. [Undertone] but I am a strong believer that charity begins at home and it should not end there. [Undertone]

HON. ALUSINE KANNEH: But mind you Mr Speaker, after you it is the Deputy Speaker.

THE SPEAKER: No but it's true that charity begins at home although it doesn't end there. It's a fact [undertones] so relax your minds and begin to accommodate the opposite sex, Good. Is there any other announcement, yes?
