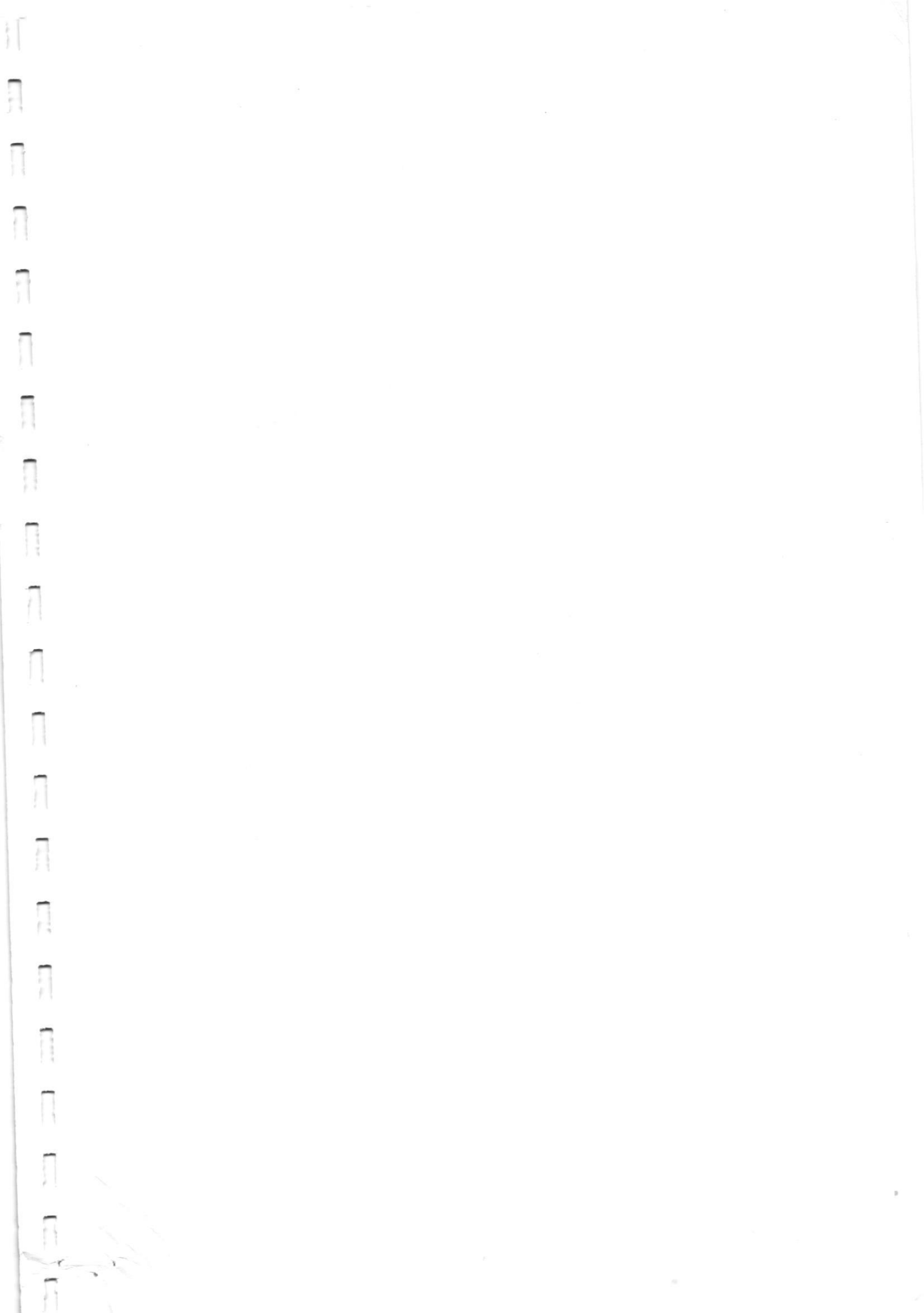




5. **Draft Procurement Plan:** The delegations reviewed the draft Procurement Plan. The negotiated text is dated August 9th, 2012, and is attachment 04 to these Minutes.
6. **Revised Operational Manual:** The delegations reviewed the revised Operational Manual. The final version will be submitted to the Bank on August 16<sup>th</sup> 2012.
7. **Closing Date:** It was agreed that an extension of the Closing Date of the Project will be considered later.
8. **Approval of Proposed Additional Financing.** The IDA Representatives clarified to the Sierra Leone Delegation that the final negotiated package will be submitted to the Vice President, Africa Region for approval in accordance with relevant policies and procedures on August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012.
9. **World Bank Access to Information Policy and Disclosure of the PAD:** The Sierra Leone Delegation also reviewed the Project Paper for any text or data that may be confidential or sensitive, or that may adversely affect the relations between the Recipient and the Association. Under the Association's Access to Information Policy date July 1st, 2010, the Project Paper, related legal agreements and other information related to the legal agreements, including any supplemental letters will be disclosed. The Sierra Leone Delegation confirmed that IDA may publicly release the version of the Project Paper agreed upon during negotiations, and also agreed to the release of the audited financial statements of the project account, as these become available. Pursuant to this policy, in due course, the Association will also disclose the Implementation Status and Results (ISR) reports for the Project.


