- HON. MANIE BETTS-PRIDDY: To ask the Minister of Foreign Affairs & International Cooperation to explain to this Honourable House:
  - (a) the circumstances that led to the loss by the Sierra Leone Government of the use of the elegant and historic premises it occupied as Chancery at 33, Portland Place, London, W1, a premises we occupied even before Sierra Leone earned its independence in 1961. 
