LIBERIAN FOREIGN AFFAIRS STUDENTS TOUR SIERRA LEONE PARLIAMENT

Parliament of Sierra Leone has, on Saturday 13/09/2025, hosted dozens of students from Gabriel L. Denis Foreign Service Institute of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Liberia, in order to foster information sharing and to bolster diplomatic ties between the two countries. The delegation undertook a study tour of the Sierra Leone Parliament, marking a significant step in fostering crossborder understanding and building the blocks for strengthening future diplomatic cooperation.

The visit aimed at providing aspiring diplomats with first-hand experience sharing of parliamentary procedures and governance.

The Deputy Clerk of Parliament, Gilbert Bosco N'habay welcomed the students on behalf of Parliament and provided update on the operations and activities of the Parliament of Sierra Leone. The Deputy Clerk of Parliament also provided detailed insights into the functions, composition, and legislative agenda of the House of Parliament; particularly the sixth Parliament.

The tour included an observational session in the Chamber of Parliament, where lawmakers converged to discuss the business of the day, a tour at the graveside of the 1st and 2nd Prime Ministers of Sierra Leone

and the entire precient of Parliament.

The Head of the Liberian delegation expressed profound gratitude for the warm reception, stating the tour was an invaluable part of their practical training.

Officials hailed the visit as a positive development for the Mano River Union integration, emphasizing that such engagements, especially among future leaders, are fundamental to strengthening the longstanding friendship and collaboration between Sierra Leone and Liberia.
