Following the completion of refurbishment of the Parliament Building, the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) on Monday, 03/ 03/ 2025, donated a Toyota Hilux to the Parliament of Sierra Leone.

Receiving the vehicle and its particulars on behalf of the Parliament of Sierra Leone, the Deputy Clerk of Parliament, Mr. Gilbert Bosco N'habay said the donation was timely.
