SIERRA LEONE'S SUCCESSION TO ECOWAS SPEAKER

Hundreds of Delegates are currently converging in Niamey, capital of Niger to witness Sierra Leone's succession for the position of Speaker of ECOWAS Parliament after Senegal.

Following President Bio's endorsement in a video played to an extraordinary Session of ECOWAS held in Liberia late last year, wooing support for Hon. Sidie M. Tunis whom he said he had known for a while and that he is an experienced Member of Parliament who would contribute towards the advancement and development of ECOWAS and that he would do well as Speaker of ECOWAS Parliament.

Hon. Tunis is the current Leader of Government Business in the Parliament of Sierra Leone representing the ruling Party from Pujehun District.

Being the Speaker of ECOWAS Parliament, Hon. Tunis will preside over deliberative sittings by using the ECOWAS Rules of Procedures and for a period of four years; before succession by Togo.

Hon. Tunis in an extraordinary ECOWAS Session in Niamey, Monday 09/03/2020 is due to be crowned Speaker of ECOWAS Parliament; after the successful four years tenure of Senegal's Moustapha Cisse' Lo.

Sierra Leone's high-powered delegation is headed by Hon. Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu, Speaker of Parliament and inclusive of all the Members of Sierra Leone's Delegation to ECOWAS Parliament, a Minister of Government, a Government Administrator of higher standing, other Members and Staff Parliament and a battery of journalists.
