About This Factsheet

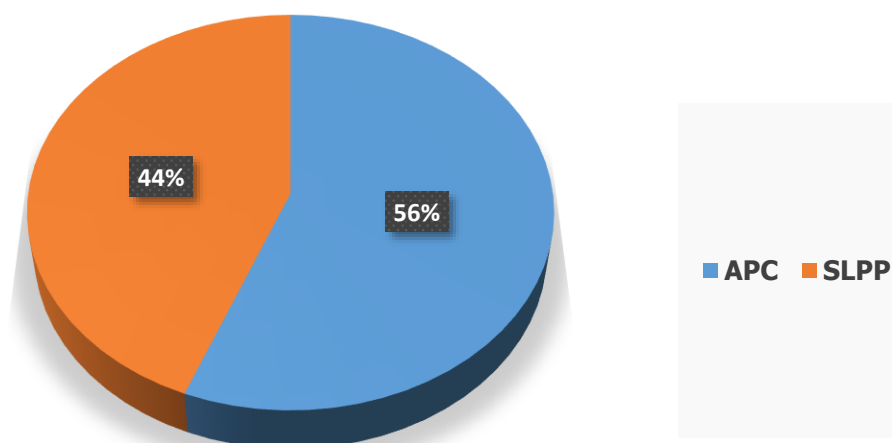
This Fact sheet contains information on female representation for the 4th and 5th Parliament in the second Republic of Sierra Leone. It has information on the names of the female Members of Parliament (MPs), their political parties and overall statistics in respect of their representation.

4th Parliament of the Second Republic of Sierra Leone Gender Profile (2012-2017)

The fourth Parliament had **112** elected MPs from **2** Political parties (APC & SLPP) and **12** Paramount Chief Members of Parliament, making it a total of **124** MPs. There were **16** Female MPs, making room for **13% representation in Parliament**.

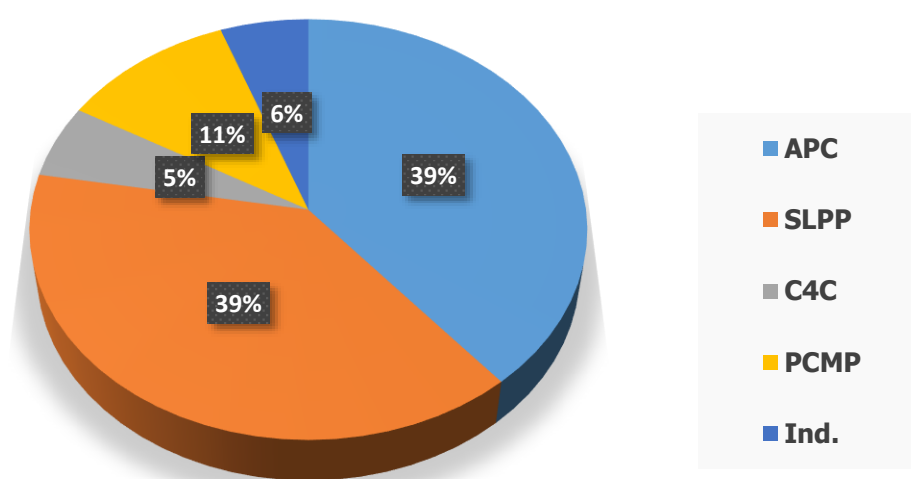

5th Parliament of the second Republic of Sierra Leone Gender Profile (2018-2023)

The 5th Parliament has **132** elected MPs and **14** Paramount Chief Members of Parliament, with a total composition of **146**. The **132** elected MPs are drawn from **4** political parties in Parliament. The current composition of female MPs is **18**, making up **12% representation in Parliament**.
