(b) ten years or more shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of eighty percent of the gross salary of a Speaker or Member of Parliament.

Application. 3. This Order shall apply to a Speaker or Member of Parliament elected as such on or after coming into operation of this Order.
