THE WORK PERMIT ACT 2023 (ACT NO 11 OF 2023)

THE WORK PERMIT (FEES) REGULATIONS 2024 Short tittle

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 27 of the Work Permit Act 2023 the Minister hereby makes the following regulations-

- 1. Unless otherwise provided, these Regulations shall be Date of deemed to come into operations on the 1st day of January 2024 Commencement
 - 2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires Interpretation

3. Pursuant to section 14 of the Act an applicant for a work Work permit permit shall pay the appropriate fees outlined under this regulation Fees before the issuance of the work permit

(1) The Minister shall not issue a work permit to a Percentage of foreigner for a job that is reserved for Sierra Leoneans. Leoneans and foreigners in certain

positions

(2) The percentage of Sierra Leoneans and foreigners employed by an employer shall conform with the following -

| Position level | Percentage of Sierra Leoneans to be employed | Percentage of Foreigners to be employed |
|-----------------------|---|--|
| Managerial position | 50% | 50% |
| Intermediate position | 50% | 50% |
| Unskilled | 100% | Nil |

- 5. (1) An employer who employs foreign workers shall Quarterly pay submit the quarterly pay roll to the Minister for inspection.
- (2) An employer who fails to comply with sub-regulation (1) commits an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine of Le10,000.00
- An employer who wishes to employ foreign workers shall Job advert for advertise the job on the electronic, print and social media for not foreigners less than one month
- A foreign employer shall submit an application to the Employment Ministry for an expatriate quota before making an application for a Quota work permit
- 8. An employer who wishes to embark on hiring workers, Employment, promotion and capacity building shall ensure that first consideration Training and Capacity is given to Sierra Leoneans. Building
- An employer who employs Sierra Leoneans and foreigners Discrimination shall put modalities in place to ensure that there is zero discrimination in his place of work
