THE COMMERCIAL AND ADMIRALTY COURT (FEES) ORDER, 2010 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 145 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991, the Rules of Court Committee hereby makes the following Order:—

The fees specified in column 2 of the Schedule shall be charged by the Commercial and Admiralty Court in respect of the matters specified in column I of the Schedule.
