

- (b) ten years or more shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of eighty percent of the gross salary of a Speaker or Member of Parliament.

Application. 3. This Order shall apply to a Speaker or Member of Parliament elected as such on or after coming into operation of this Order.

THE STATE SALARIES (PENSION OF SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT) ORDER, 2006 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on Parliament by subsection (2) of section 5 of the State Salaries, Pensions, Gratuities and Other Benefits Act, 2003, the Speaker of Parliament hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 2nd day of April, 1996. Commencement.
2. The Speaker or a Member of Parliament who has served as such for a period of— Computation of pension of Speaker and Members of Parliament.
  - (a) not less than five years but less than ten years, shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of forty percent of the gross salary of a Speaker or Member of Parliament;
