THE STATE SALARIES, PENSIONS, GRATUITIES AND OTHER BENEFITS ACT, 2003 (Act No. 4 of 2003).

THE PRESIDENTS, VICE-PRESIDENTS, MINISTERS AND DEPUTY MINISTERS Short title. (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) ORDER, 2008.

In exercise of the powers conferred on Parliament by subsection (2) of section 5 of the State Salaries, Pensions, Gratuities and Other Benefits Act, 2003, the Speaker of Parliament hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on Commencement. the 2nd day of April 1996.
- 2. The President and Vice President shall be entitled to the Conditions of salary and other conditions of service specified in columns 3 and 4 service of respectively of the Schedule.

President and Vice-President.

(1) A Minister who has served as such for a period of—Pension for

Ministers and

- (a) not less than five years but less than ten Deputy years shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of forty percent of his gross salary;
- (b) ten years or more shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of eighty percent of his gross salary.
- (2) A Deputy Minister who has served as such for a period of-

- (a) not less than five years but less than ten years, shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of forty percent of his gross salary;
- (b) ten years or more shall be entitled to a monthly pension computed at the rate of eighty percent of his gross salary.

Death of President or Vice-President.

- 4. (1) On the death of the President or Vice-President, the spouse shall be entitled to his pension for a period not exceeding twelve years.
- (2) Where the President or Vice President has more than one wife, his pension shall, where appropriate be shared among them equally until the death of any one of them.

Spouse married after retirement.

5. These Rules shall not apply to the spouse of a President or Vice-President whose marriage is contracted after the President or Vice-President has left office.

Monies to be paid in leone equivalent.

6. All monies expressed in dollars in the Schedule shall be paid, where appropriate in the leone equivalent at the time of the payment.
