

Pronouncement of Quorum at 10:18 am:

The Table Clerk / Procedural Adviser, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, made the following pronouncement as quoted: "Mr. Speaker, Hon. Members. Pursuant to Section 89 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991 (Act No. 6 of 1991) in tandem with S.O. 7(1) of the Standing Orders of Parliament, this House has formed a quorum to commence its proceedings."

1. Prayers were read by Mr. Prince Oviasuyi (Table Clerk/Procedural Adviser).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of SO 5 (2) at 10:18 am was moved by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie from Bo District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Emilia Lolloh Tongi from Kailahun District** and approved by the House.

3. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker **(Segepoh Solomon Thomas)** informed the House that the adoption of the records of votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 5th and Thursday 7th August, 2025 respectively would be done on the next adjourned date as a result of some technical issues.

Mr. Speaker stood down the House at 10:25 a.m. The House resumed at 10:45 a.m.
