
The House Met at 10:00 a.m. The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu, Presided.





1. Prayers were read by Mr. Edward Sahr Lebbie (Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:30 am:

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:20 am was moved by **Hon. Veronica K. Sesay of Moyamba District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Abdul Karim Bangura of Karene District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 18th August, 2023:The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 18th August, 2023 was moved by **Hon. Habib Keifa Fabba of Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Kanneh of Kailahun District** and adopted by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, welcomed Hon. Members to the House after the long recess. He said that he had hoped to welcome all the members of both the Opposition and the Ruling side but lamented that it was still a forlorn hope. He recognized Hon. Mohamed **Bangura** as the Acting Leader of the Opposition who also doubled as a new Member of the ECOWAS Parliament. On behalf of the House, He extended a hearty congratulations to Hon. Mohamed Bangura and Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina as the newly sworn members of the ECOWAS Parliament representing the Sierra Leone Parliament. He stated that the invitation that he had extended to the 52 APC Members of the Opposition was not open-ended because Parliament was a House of laws, and that Hon. Members were responsible to make the laws, and therefore, they must be the first people to respect the laws. He reminded the House that the sitting for that date was the 23rd sitting day of the Sixth Parliament and that it only remained seven sitting days to the date of closure for the 52 APC Members that had been missing sittings. He reminded the House that the law about absenteeism was not an ordinary law. He referred the House to Section 77 (e) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6) of 1991 read in conjunction with S.O. 77 (2) (a) of the Standing Orders of Parliament. He said that the reading of these combined provisions conveyed a very clear message, and he, thereby, charged the Acting Leader of the Opposition (Hon. Mohamed Bangura) to deliver his message to his colleagues.

Hon. Mohamed Bangura assured the House that the 52 APC Members-Elect would resume their seats by the next sitting after they had concluded negotiations with the Government of Sierra Leone.
