1. Prayers were read by Mr. Alimamy Lincoln-Bangura (Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:20

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:20 am was moved by **Hon. Veronica K. Sesay Moyamba District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mustapha Musa Sellu of Moyamba District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Monday 14th August, 2023: The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Monday 14th August, 2023 was moved by **Hon. Abdulai Osman Charles of Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Rebecca Yei Kamara of Kono District** and adopted by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that the Deputy Speaker would take over as the presiding officer of the proceedings for that day's sitting as he was not feeling well. He referred the House to S. O. 10 (3) and read the said provision as quoted: "**Mr. Speaker may, at any time, ask the Deputy Speaker to take the Chair temporarily without formal communication to the House."**

Mr. Speaker stood down the House at 11:00 p.m. for the Deputy Speaker to take over as the presiding officer.

The House resumed at 11:05 p.m.

Point of Order:

The Deputy Leader 1 of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie**, stood on a point of order and stated that all Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) should be fully represented in the Chamber to listen to the issues raised by Hon. Members as the House would start discussing the Presidential Address. He, thereby, moved a motion for a roll-call to be done and to summon all MDAs to attend the five-allotted day's debate on the Presidential Speech. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Bo District** and approved by the House.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Speaker, **Hon. Segepoh S. Thomas**, agreed with the submission made by **Hon. Bashiru Silikie**. He directed the Clerks-at-the-Table to bring forth the register so that a roll call would be done.

Plea by The Leader of Government Business:

The Leader of Government Business and Majority Leader, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma**, informed the House that public notices had been sent to all MDAs to witness the debate on the Presidential Speech, and that those MDAs should not





send a representative below the rank of a Director if the Permanent Secretary was not available. He further informed the House that the MDAs had sought the excuse of the House for their absence for that day's sitting as they were attending induction training on administrative protocols. He, thereby, pleaded with Mr. Speaker to see reasons with their excuse.

Mr. Speaker's Note of Caution:

The Speaker, **Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, gave a note of caution to all MDAs that they should be represented in the Chamber to witness the debate on the Presidential Address for lest that they should be held for contempt of Parliament.
