- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 11:40 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 11:40 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Tennyson Hindolo Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District** and approved by the House.

#### 6. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District moved another motion to amend the Order Paper by expunging item IV (Bill) from the Order Paper due to technical challenges. The motion was seconded by Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Constituency 130, Western Urban and approved by the House.

#### **Standing Order 25 (Notice of Motions)**

The Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie** stood and gave a Notice of Motion. He said a few years ago, there was an agreement ratified by the House with the Government of Sierra Leone and Net Page to move the passport from machine readable to an e-Passport. He said the initial price for a passport by then was (Le 100,000) one hundred thousand old Leones and later shifted to (Le 500,000) five hundred thousand old Leones. It was further pegged to one hundred dollars (\$100) and the reason brought forward was because the passport was going to be an e-Passport. To date he said, the passport was still a machine readable instead of an e-Passport and he could confirm that. He said that the transition that was to have taken place did not happen and the citizens were paying for a machine readable passport than an e-passport and at a cost of one hundred dollars (\$100). He therefore moved that the Minister of Internal Affairs be invited to Parliament to explain the reasons why they had not been able to transition to an e-Passport and why the people were still paying for it at that price? Also, if they could not transition to an e-Passport they should revert to the normal price that was in existence before it was pegged to \$100.

**Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas of Constituency 089, Bonthe District** supported the statement of the Acting Leader. He said that they had started the fight to correct the said issue since the start of the 5<sup>th</sup> Parliament and they wished to complete it before Parliament dissolves.

#### Mr. Speaker's Ruling

Mr. Speaker directed that by the next sitting of Parliament that was scheduled for Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2023, the Minister of Internal Affairs should be summoned before Parliament to explain the reason why they had not transitioned to an e-passport.

Also, the Minister should be prepared to explain to the House about the \$25 levied on passengers at the airport in and out of the jurisdiction of Sierra Leone.

He specifically requested that the Chairman of the Committee on Internal Affairs should convey the message to the Minister; that he had been summoned by Parliament to give an explanation about the said issues and that the summon should be answered on the next adjourned date.
