- 1. Mr. Speaker was in his seat at 10:00 a.m.
- 2. Prayers were read by Mr. Prince Oviasuyi (Table Clerk).
- 3. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:40 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:40 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Yusuf Mackery of Constituency 087, Bo District** and approved by the House.

4. Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2021:

The motion for the adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2021** was moved by **Hon. Brima Mansaray of Constituency 017, Kenema District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Kanneh of Constituency 006, Kailahun District** and adopted by the House.

### 5. Mr. Speaker's Announcements:

- (i) The Acting Speaker, Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas, expressively informed the House and especially the Leadership of political parties about his dissatisfaction over the level of absenteeism. He said as quoted: "In the not too distant future, the Office of the Speakership would be making relevant orders to curb this level of absenteeism in Parliament." He said that it was not honourable at all to continue receiving salaries without doing the jobs that Hon. Members had been elected for. He stated that he was extremely disappointed about the level of absenteeism for the all the days that he had been presiding.
- (ii) The Acting Speaker, **Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas,** also pleaded with Hon. Members to be writing letters to Chairmen of Committees when they had issues relating to Committees instead of using Standing Order 23. He stated that the provision of S.O. 23 could not accommodate debatable or contentious issues. He said that as quoted "70 % of the work of Parliament is done by Committees." He advised all Chairmen of Committees to be responsive when letters relating to queries had been sent to them. He further advised that Chairmen of Committees should try as best as possible to instruct their clerks to invite the relevant parties for amicable actions when letters of queries relating to their purview had been received.

# 6. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by replacing Hon. Lahai Marah of Constituency 042, Falaba District (Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Water Resources) with Hon.
