- 2. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).
- **3. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 10th November, 2023:** The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 10th November, 2023 was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Brima Mansaray of Kenema District** and adopted by the House.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu continued to commend Hon. Members for being punctual for the prompt commencement of proceedings as dictated mandatorily in Standing Order 5(2). He further said he would continue to commend Hon. Members until they imbibe the culture of prompt start. He said that he was aware that it would be an onerous task but he would not get tired. He specifically commended the new members across the aisle for demonstrating a sense of responsibility and punctuality and also some of the old members from the Fifth Parliament who had been equally responsible to the demands of S.O. 5(2).

The Deputy Minority Leader 1, **Hon. Daniel B. Koroma** took the cue from Mr. Speaker to thank both Whips across the aisle for rallying around their Members to get a quorum and be seated for the prompt start of proceedings. He said the Whips in the Sixth Parliament were up to their task and that Mr. Speaker would not be disappointed. Therefore, the suspension of S.O. 5(2) in tandem with Section 97 paragraphs (a) & (b) of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone, Act No.6 of 1991 would be discouraged going forward. He joined Mr. Speaker to acknowledge the efforts of the Whips and encouraged them to continue.

Mr. Speaker duly noted the statement from the Deputy Minority Leader 1, and further thanked both Whips especially Hon. Ibrahim Tawa Conteh for his exemplary leadership overtime in the Sixth Parliament. He further said that both Whips (Hon. Ibrahim Tawa Conteh of Western Area Urban and Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara of Kambia) were two of a kind and that he expected nothing less but diligent discharge of their responsibilities.

7. TRIBUTE

The Table Clerk, Mr. Edward Sahr Lebbie read out the motion as stated on the Order Paper:

Tribute to the memory of the late Honourable P.C. Brima Victor Sidi Kebbie. Former Member of the Sierra Leone Parliament.

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu stated the reason for the tribute of the late P.C. Kebbie in the well of Parliament for the first time and not the State Hall. He said that Parliament had planned on going ahead with its normal practice which was to lay in state the corpse of Hon. Members at the entrance of the State Hall and give a tribute, but he had received a call from the Minister of Local Government that the Council of Paramount Chiefs had met and stopped the ceremony to be performed in Parliament. The Minister further said that the Council of Paramount Chiefs had demanded that the late Chief should be taken to his home town first where their traditional rites should be performed before any other activity.

It was in that regard that Mr. Speaker made the decision to have the tribute at a later date where the family of the late Chief would be invited to grace the occasion.
