1. Prayers were read by Mr. Edward Sahr Lebbie (Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:30 am:

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:30 am was moved by **Hon. Veronica K. Sesay of Moyamba District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie of Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Sililkie of Bo District, moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by replacing the initial proposer (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma) with Hon. Bashiru Silikie and the initial seconder (Hon. Bashiru Silikie) with Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina on item "iv" (Motion of the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service) respectively. The motion was seconded by Hon. Sarty Banya of Kailahun District and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 12th October, 2023:The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 12th October, 2023 was moved by **Hon. Habib Keifa Fabba of Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Massay Aruna Ngahinteh of Bo District** and adopted by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu, conveyed his congratulations on behalf of the House to the two parties represented in the Sixth Parliament (SLPP and APC) for the three days successful dialogue held at Bintumani Conference Center. He informed the House about the Communiqué of the dialogue and believed that it was in place for the furtherance of our democracy. He said that the whole House would welcome the 52 APC Members-Elect and ensure that the needful was done namely the swearing-in ceremony that would legally and effectively make them full-fledged Members of Parliament. He underlined one fundamental principle by stating that the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6) of 1991 was predicated on the existence and maintenance of a multi-party democracy. He stated that the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone totally condemned a one-party system of governance and that means at all times the composition of Parliament should be democratic with at least two parties represented in the House. He said because of the aforementioned fundamental principle, he had been urging the Members of the Opposition to see the need and reason to come and represent their electorate that voted them into Parliament so that the said Hon. Members could perform their constitutional duties accordingly. In advance, he extended a very warm hand of felicitations filled with the utmost expectations that before the House rose, they would enjoy the company of the Members of the Opposition. Finally, he said that his humble self and Members of Parliament present were so expectant that they would have the honour and real privilege of welcoming the Members of the Opposition before the end of the proceedings.





5. Motion of the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service

Proposer: Hon. Bashiru Silikie

Seconder: Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina

Hon. Bashiru Silikie moved as quoted — "Be it Resolved: That the Eight Report of the First Session of the Sixth Parliament of the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service be adopted by the House and that the Recommendations Contained therein be approved."

The Acting Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Appointments and the Public Service, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Bo District**, presented the Eight Report of the First Session of the Sixth Parliament of the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service on the vetting of the following Presidential Nominees and the recommendations contained therein:

- 1. Mr. Hadji Dabo Proposed Director General, National Minerals Agency (NMA).
- 2. Dr. Edward Hinga Sandy Proposed Executive Director, National Investment Board (NIB).
- 3. Mr. Ahmed Tijan Fadlu-Deen Proposed Ambassador, Sierra Leone Embassy, Qatar.
- 4. Mr. Emerson Kamara Proposed Deputy Commissioner, National Youth Commission.
- 5. Mr. Lansana Wurie Kelfala- Proposed Chairman, Sierra Leone Teaching Service Commission (SLTSC).
- 6. Dr. Bondi Gevao— Proposed Chairman, Nuclear Safety and Radiation Protection Board.

Excerpt of the Ninth Sitting of the Seventh Report:

- 7. Dr. Abu Bakarr Karim Proposed Ambassador, Sierra Leone Embassy People's Republic of China.

Mr. Speaker's Ruling:

Before he proposed the question for debate, the Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu asked the Acting Chairman of the Appointments Committee whether the three nominees appointed for diplomatic positions did present their **agrément.** He informed the House that before the interviews were held for the three nominees for diplomatic positions, he enquired from the Leader of Government Business (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma) whether the three nominees had presented their **agrément**. He then advised that the three nominees for diplomatic appointments should not be interviewed until their **agrément** were presented to the House, but the Leader of Government Business pleaded with him by saying that the three nominees for diplomatic appointments were just going to be interviewed, and that they would not be presented to the House for approval until their **agrément** were presented. He said the moment the interviews for the three nominees were done, he started receiving pressures from different quarters seeking the approval for the three nominees by the House. With modesty, he informed the House that he had three degrees of which two were on specializations. He said he had: an LLB Honours from the National University of Australia in 1969, and he had LLM Hons. and PhD in International and Constitutional Law from the University of Cambridge, and that he had practised law since he was called to the bar for over fifty years. He stated that the approval of the three nominees in a case of that nature would be the utmost exception because he did not want youngsters to come after he had left the office of the Speakership and guestion the wrongness of the procedures under his watch. He, thereby, ruled that from then henceforth, no nominee for any diplomatic appointment abroad should be interviewed by the Appointments Committee until the following documents including the other requirements by the Appointments Committee were tendered before the House: (1) Letter of Appointment by the President, (2) The Agrément from the receiving country to which the said diplomat would be proceeded to.

Mr. Speaker proposed the question for debate.
