2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:50

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:50 am was moved by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Pujehun District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Falaba District** and approved by the House.

3. Mr. Speaker's Statement:

Due to the unavailability of the Votes and Proceedings in both hard and soft copies as a result of some technical glitches, the Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, stated that the House would not continue postponing the consideration and adoption of the Votes and Proceedings, and that the House would not go on like that indefinitely.
