## 2. Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:25 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:25 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Veronica Kadie Sesay from Moyamba District** for commencement of plenary proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Massay Aruna Ngahinteh from Bo District** and approved by the House.

**3.** Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>February, 2024: The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 was moved by Hon. Habib Keifa Fabbah from Bo District. It was seconded by Hon. Joseph Williams Lamin from Bo District and adopted by the House.

### 4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** referred the House to Standing Order 19 (Questions to Ministers). He stated that House grappled extensively with no result during the Fifth Parliament to implement the said provision but it was their intention to succeed in the Sixth Parliament. He further said that one of the duties of Parliament was to hold the Executive to account, and a way to achieve that was to summon Ministers before Parliament to give account of any matter falling within their portfolio. He informed the House that the leadership after consultation had agreed and proposed to set aside the last Wednesday of each month exclusively to fully implement the provision of S.O. 19. He went on to say, that day would only be confirmed after the Chief Minister would have responded to the memo sent to him, informing him about the new development. He further explained that Parliament would not invite all the Ministers to be present during Question Time but that a Minister or two at a time would be invited as and when necessary. He therefore encouraged Members to ask questions and if those questions were not answered that month, they would be reserved for the following month.

### 5. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Majority Leader, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie** moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by replacing the **Seconder** of the Motion of the Committee on Appointments and the Public Service **Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina** with **Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara from Kambia District.** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams Lamin from Bo District** and approved by the House.
