	THIRD READING AND PASSAGE INTO LAW: The Bill was read the third time and unanimously passed into law.

Braima from Kailahun Districted), that the first Principal of Kenema Government Secondary School was an Edwardian, and therefore Kenema Government Secondary School must pay credence to St. Edwards Secondary School. 2. Hon. Dr. Foday I. Sumah – that people go to the toilets and smoke, therefore anti-smoking regulations must be enforced, since Parliament is a no smoking area. 3. Hon. Chernor R.M.
