- **1.** Prayers were read by Mr. Alimamy Lincoln-Bangura (Table Clerk).
- 2. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 22nd November, 2023: The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 22nd November, 2023 was moved by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Bo District. It was seconded by Hon. Alice Kornya Sandy of Kenema District and adopted by the House as amended.

Mr. Speaker Called upon the Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie**, to update the House about the availability of the estimates together with the indispensable attendance of senior representatives from various Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) to witness the budgetary debate.

The Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie**, updated the House that for the budgetary estimates, the Ministry of Finance was assiduously working to make them available to the House. As for the attendance of senior representatives from MDAs, he asked to do a roll call, but first asked Mr. Speaker to stand down the House for thirty minutes for their presence to acknowledge in the House. He stated that if those MDAs failed to send representatives before the expiration of the thirty minutes that he had pleaded for, the House would be left with no option but to recommend to the Committees of Supplies to withhold their budgets.

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Abdul Kargbo**, drew the attention of the House to the absence of the Minister of Finance.

Mr. Speaker agreed to stand down the House for thirty minutes so that the leverage of time would be given to see the presence of representatives from MDAs and the Minister of Finance.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, stated that he would never get tired of reminding all Hon. Members including himself of their sacred obligation to The Republic of Sierra Leone. He said that no one else from outside of Sierra Leone would come and develop Sierra Leone for them. He thanked all Hon. Members that had demonstrated a sense of leadership by examples. He commended Hon. Members for respecting the time of starting the proceedings of the House as dictated by the Standing Orders on time. He admonished Hon. Members not to disappoint the Nation and themselves by deviating from the path they had been charged with.

The Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie**, admonished all MDAs to send their representatives from at least deputy permanent secretary or deputy director to witness the budgetary debate in the House before the expiration of 30 minutes. He said if they failed to do so, the House would be left with no option but to do other whiles.





The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Abdul Kargbo**, drew the attention of the House to the live coverage of the debate.

Mr. Speaker stood down the House at 11:05 p.m. The House resumed at 11:15 p.m.
