- 2. Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:30 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:25 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams Lamin** from **Bo District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Kanneh** from **Kailahun District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Records of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 7th May, 2024:
The motion for the adoption of the Records of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 7th May, 2024 was moved by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin from Bo District. It was seconded by Hon. Momoh Bockarie from Kenema District and adopted by the House.

4. Swearing-In of Members of Parliament (Third Schedule of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone.)

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, stated that in conformity with the certificate of elections received from the Electoral Commission for Sierra Leone (ECSL), he, thereby, declared that the following had been duly elected as Members of Parliament of the Republic of Sierra Leone. Pursuant to Section 83 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991 (Act No. 6 of 1991) in tandem with Standing Order 1 A of the Parliament of Sierra Leone (Hon. Moses Andrew Edwin from Bonthe District, P.C. Alameen Kanneh from Kenema District and P.C. Saffa Moyna Tamu from PujehunDistrict). The Hon. Rt. Speaker, Segepoh Solomon Thomas called upon the Clerk of Parliament to administer the oath of office as established in the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991.

Administering of Oath of Allegiance:

Before administering the oath of office, The Acting Clerk of Parliament (Madam Finda Fraser) invited the Leadership of the House to join her in administering the oath of office. The Acting Clerk then called upon the newly elected Members of Parliament (Hon. Moses Andrew Edwin from Bonthe District, P.C. Alameen Kanneh from Keneba District and P.C. Saffa Moyna Tamu from Pujehun Distrct respectively) and administered the "Oath of Office" as established in the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991 as quoted: "I ... do hereby (in the name of God swear) that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the Republic of Sierra Leone as by law established, that I will uphold and defend the Constitution of Sierra Leone, and that I will faithfully and conscientiously discharge the duties of a Member of Parliament. (So help me God.)"Having subscribed the oath of office and appended their signature on the Oath Book, The Acting Clerk presented the newly sworn-in Members of Parliament with a package that contained: (The Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991, The Standing Orders of Parliament, The Parliament Act, 2023 and The Parliamentary Prayers).





Mr. Speaker's Welcome Statement:

On behalf of the entire House, The Hon. Rt. Speaker, **Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, extended his hearty and warm welcome to the newly sworn-in Members of Parliament (**Hon. Moses Andrew Edwin, P.C. Alameen Kanneh and P.C. Saffa Moyna Tamu).** He admonished them to make the best use of the books presented to them, as they were very important to the proceedings of Parliament. He again congratulated them.
