



- 1. Prayers were read by Mr. Edward Sahr Lebbie (Table Clerk).
- 2. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 22nd November, 2023: The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 22nd November, 2023 was moved by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Bo District. It was seconded by Hon. Neneh Lebbie of Bo District and adopted by the House as amended.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, again thanked all Hon. Members for being dutiful to their calling as Members of Parliament especially those seated and were awaiting the commencement of proceedings on time. Mr. Speaker said that he hoped it was not a fluke; rather it would be a pattern of behavior. He further said that mindsets were developed through consistency in human activities and actions. He encouraged them to shed the bad habits away and substitute in its place good habits. He commended all members especially the new members for starting on a good footing by demonstrating an unquestionable profound sense of responsibility and he as Speaker was impressed.

Mr. Speaker further enquired from the Acting Majority Leader about the MDAs who were present to witness the debate.

In response, the Acting Majority Leader, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie** said that the MDAs were being registered by the clerks at that moment and that a role call would be done before and after lunch. He further said that if any MDA was not represented, they as Leaders would advise the committee responsible for scrutinizing their budget to critically examine it and make recommendations to the House.

5. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Majority Leader, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie** moved a motion for the amendment of the Order Paper by replacing the word "**Third**" with "**Second**" on item IV (Bill). The motion was seconded by **Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Western Area Urban District** and approved by the House.

Observation by the Deputy Minority Leader 1

The Deputy Minority Leader 1, **Hon. Daniel B. Koroma** humbly suggested that a biometric register be provided at the remaining two entrance points that were without the technology. He said, that would serve as a reminder to all MPs to register and in a swiftly manner before they could access the chamber, especially when Mr. Speaker would have been seated.

Mr. Speaker's Response

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, admonished the Deputy Minority Leader 1, **Hon. Daniel B. Koroma** and the House by extension, to confine their debate within the 10 minutes allocated to each speaker. By doing so, he said, they would be able to accommodate more speakers.

Statement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, stated that the incident that had occurred in the well of Parliament demonstrated the fragility of the peace that the dialogue between the two major political parties produced. He again reminded the House about the pertinent provisions that underpinned the debate on the Second Reading of the Appropriation Bill, and by way of reminder, cited the said provisions so that matters that were extremely extraneous to the debate would not be brought into the debate.

He read out the provision of Standing Order 63(3) as quoted "After the Bill has been read the first time, it shall be put down for Second Reading not less than two clear days thereafter and five days shall be allotted for the Second Reading of the Bill. The debate shall be confined to the financial and economic state of Sierra Leone and the general principles of Government policy and administration as indicated by the Bill and its Estimates"

Mr. Speaker further said that the provision he had quoted was amplified in Standing Order 32(5) which he also read as quoted "A Member must confine his observations to the subject under discussion and may not introduce matter irrelevant thereto."

Mr. Speaker said, by the introduction of matters that were completely extraneous to the Second Reading of the Appropriation Bill, the Hon. Member had displayed fragrant violation of the Standing Orders. He further ruled that he would not entertain any Hon. Member to stray beyond the subject matter. Mr. Speaker concluded by urging all Hon. Members to confine their debate to the Appropriation Budget that was read by the Minister of Finance.


