- 1. Prayers were read by Mr. Alimamy Lincoln Bangura (Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of SO 5 (2) at 10:18 am was moved by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie from Bo District.** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Rebecca Yei Kamara from Kono District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 10th June, 2025:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 10th June, 2025 was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin from Bo District.** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Kanneh** from **Kailahun District** and adopted by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that the Bill entitled: "The Investment Framework Agreement (Ratification) Act, 2025" with the long title: "Being an Act to provide for the ratification by Parliament of the Investment Framework Agreement for investment in and development of Sherbro Island between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone of the one part and Sherbro Alliance Partners Limited of the other part and to provide for other related matters" had been read the Third Time and passed into law.
