### 3. Bill:

The National Early Warning and Response Mechanism Centre Act, 2025 by The Minister of Planning and Economic Development.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, called upon the Minister of Planning and Economic Development to proceed with the Introduction and First Reading of the Bill.

# **Introduction and First Reading:**





The Minister of Planning and Economic Development, **Kenyeh Ballay**, moved that the Bill entitled: **"The National Early Warning and Response Mechanism Centre Act, 2025"** be read the First Time.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote as quoted:

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that the Bill entitled: "The National Early Warning and Response Mechanism Centre Act, 2025" had been read the <u>First Time</u>.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, called upon the Minister of Planning and Economic Development to proceed with the Second Reading of the Bill.

### **Second Reading:**

The Minister of Planning and Economic Development, **Kenyeh Ballay**, moved that the bill entitled: "**The National Early Warning and Response Mechanism Centre Act, 2025"** be read the Second Time. She presented the objects and reasons of the Bill to the House and again moved that the Bill be read the Second Time.

The Minister of Planning and Economic Development, **Kenyeh Ballay**, moved that Parts 1 to 6; Clauses 1 to 26 and the schedule stand part of the Bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started. Some amendments were made.

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote as quoted:

"All those in favour, say Aye."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 1 to 6; Clauses 1 to 26 and the schedule had formed part of the Bill as amended."

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

## **Report Stage:**





The Minister of Planning and Economic Development, **Kenyeh Ballay**, reported to the House that the Bill entitled: **"The National Early Warning and Response Mechanism Centre Act, 2025"** had gone through Committee of the Whole House with some amendments made.

### **Third Reading:**

The Minister of Planning and Economic Development, **Kenyeh Ballay**, moved that the Bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote as quoted:

"All those in favor, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that the bill entitled: "The National Early Warning and Response Mechanism Centre Act, 2025" had been read the Third Time and passed into law.

# 5. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanation):

**Hon. Mustapah M. Sellu,** from **Moyamba District,** commended the Leadership for the improvement in the security of Parliament. However, he noted that the CCTV cameras are active within the well but inactive around the lobby, and if anything happens beyond that area, it cannot be captured. He also mentioned that some sensitive areas within the Parliament cannot be monitored. He informed the House about an incident that took place last week where he and another Hon. Member lost their phone and key. Upon checking the CCTV footage, the footage could not trace the items. He pleaded that the House should look into that and make available CCTV cameras at strategic and sensitive areas within Parliament in order to improve the security as soon as possible.
