Entry of the Clerks-at-the Table

Officer in charge - The Director General of Parliament (Madam Finda F. Fraser)

Announcement by The Director General of Parliament:

The Director General– "Hon. Members, I announce the unavoidable absence of both the Speaker and the Deputy Speaker. Pursuant to paragraph (c) of Section 88 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No.6) of 1991 and Standing Order 10 (1), this House may therefore elect from amongst its Members, a person to preside over today's proceedings."

Nominations: The Director General: "I therefore call for nominations."

Hon. Mariama Munia Zombo- moved a motion that **Hon. Veronica K. Sesay** did take the Chair as presiding officer for that day's proceedings.

Hon. Rugiatu Rosay Kanu– seconded the motion.

The Director General put the question for vote as quoted: "That **Hon. Veronica K. Sesay** does take the chair as presiding officer for today's proceedings."

"All those in favour, say aye." "All those against, say nay."

Through collection of voices, the Director General declared that the ayes had it, and that the motion had been carried.

1. Prayers were read by Mr. Alimamy Lincoln-Bangura (Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:26 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:45 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Musa Fofanah** from **Kono District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Fatmata Sarah Soukenah** from **Western Urban District** and approved by the House.

3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Majority Leader, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma, from Kenema District** moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by expunging item **VI (Bill).** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara** from **Kambia District** and approved by the House.

5. Madam Speaker's Announcement:

Report on the 64th Session of the Organization of African Caribbean Pacific States (OACPS) Parliamentary Assembly and the First Session of the OACP-EU Joint Parliamentary Assembly after the Samao Agreement held on Luanda, Angola from $17^{th} - 21^{st}$ February, 2024.

8. Government Motion by the Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Alimamy Lincoln-Bangura**, called upon the Minister of **Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation** to proceed with the motion.

The Minister of **Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation**, **Mr. Timothy M. Kabba**, presented the motion to the House and moved its ratification with the following words as quoted:

"Be it resolved: That this Honourable House hereby ratifies the following Agreements and Treaty which were laid on the Table of the House on Thursday 25th and Tuesday 30th January 2024 respectively:

- (i) Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.
- (ii) Cooperation Agreement in the Field of Vocation Training between the Office of Vocational, Training and Employment Promotion, and the Morocco International Cooperation Agency (AMCI) of the Kingdom of Morocco and The Ministry of Higher and Technical Education of the Republic of Sierra Leone.
- (iii) Framework Cooperation Agreement relation to the granting of Academic Scholarships, Internships and sharing of Expertise between the Kingdom of Morocco represented by (Moroccan Agency for International Cooperation-AMCI) And the Republic of Sierra Leone represented by the Ministry of Higher and Technical Education.
- (iv) Agreement between the Kingdom of Morocco and the Republic of Sierra Leone for the reciprocal promotion and protection of investment.
