

1. Prayers were read by Mr. Alimamy Lincoln-Bangura (Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:25 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:25 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Bernadette Wuyatta Songa** from **Kailahun District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Alice Jebbeh Kumabeh** from **Bonthe District** and approved by the House.

3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Majority Leader and Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma from Kenema District**, moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by expunging sub item VI under item V (A) – (Laying of Papers by The Minister of transport and Aviation). He also moved to amend the Order Paper that the document that ought to have been laid by the Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources would be laid by himself (The Majority Leader and Leader of Government Business). The motion was seconded by **Hon. Emilia Lolloh Tongi** from **Kailahun District** and approved by the House.

4. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Majority Leader and Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma from Kenema District**, again moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by changing the year on the bill entitled: **The Industrial Relations and Trade Union Act, 2023** instead of 2024 due to the fact that the House had not made any amendment on it through its Committee Stage. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Bashiru Silikie** from **Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Records of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 23rd May, 2024:

The motion for the adoption of the Records of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 23rd May 2024 was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin** from **Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Fatmata Sarah Soukenah** from **Western Urban District** and adopted by the House.





4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Segepoh Solomon Thomas, informed the House that Mr. Gilbert Bosco N'habay had been appointed as the Acting Deputy Clerk of Parliament, and that he had incidentally become the Acting Clerk of Parliament. As a result of the retirement of Mr. Mohamed Lebbie the erstwhile Deputy Clerk of Parliament. He noted that the Parliamentary Service Commission (PSC) met and decided that Mr. Gilbert Bosco N'habay be appointed. Mr. Speaker asked Hon. Members to refer to Mr. Gilbert Bosco N'habay concerning anything that related to the office of the Clerk as the House was still waiting for the substantive Clerk of Parliament.

5. Laying of Papers:

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Alimamy Lincoln-Bangura** called upon the Minister of Transports and Aviation to lay the papers as itemized on the Order Paper as amended.

(A) Papers laid by the Deputy Minister of Transport and Aviation:

The Deputy Minister of Transports and Aviation, Mr. Rex Bonapha, laid the following papers:

- i. Air Transport Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone and the Government of the Czech Republic, Dated 5th December, 2023.

- iii. Bilateral Air Service Agreement between the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia and the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone, Dated July 2000.
- iv. Administrative Package for Ratification of the Protocol Amending Article 56 of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, Dated 6th October, 2016.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Alimamy Lincoln Bangura**, called upon the Leader of Government Business to lay the Paper that was itemized on the Order Paper as amended.

(B) Paper laid by the Majority Leader and Leader of Government Business:

The Majority Leader and Leader of Government Business (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma from Kenema District) rose on S O 18 (5) and laid the following paper:

Agreement on Fisheries Subsidies. Ministerial Decision, Dated 17th June 2022. Ministerial Conference Twelfth Session Held in Geneva, 12th – 15th June, 2022.

Mr. Speaker stood down the House at 10:25 am.

The House resumed at 10:50 am.

6. Bill: The Industrial Relations and Trade Union Act, 2023 by The Minister of Labour and Social Security.

Committee Stage: The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.

Presentation of Report:

The Chairman of the Legislative Committee, **Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh** from **Western Urban District**, presented the Second Report of the First Session of the Sixth Parliament of the Legislative Committee on the bill entitled **"The Industrial Relations and Trade Union Act, 2023."**

I. The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 1 to 6; Clauses 1 to 62 stand part of the bill.

The Minister of Labour and Social Security, **Mr. Rahman Swarray**, moved that Parts 1 to 6; Clauses 1 to 62 stand part of the bill.





Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

7. Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 12 Noon:

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 12 noon was moved by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie** from **Bo District** for the proceedings to continue during lunch. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin** from **Bo District** and approved by the House.

Proceedings Continued:

The debate started, and some amendments were made.

The Minister of Labour and Social Security, **Mr. Rahman Swarray**, again moved that Parts 1 to 6; Clauses 1 to 62 stand part of the bill as amended.

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favor, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 1 to 6; Clauses 1 to 62 had formed part of the bill as amended.

8. Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 3:00

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 3 pm. was moved by **Hon. Veronica K. Sesay** from **Moyamba District** for the proceedings to continue after the said time. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara** from **Kambia District** and approved by the House.

Proceedings Continued.

Report Stage:

The Minister of Labour and Social Security, **Mr. Rahman Swarray**, reported to the House that the bill entitled: **"The Industrial Relations and Trade Union Act, 2024"** had gone through Committee of the Whole House with some amendments made.

Third Reading:

The Minister of Labour and Social Security, **Mr. Rahman Swarray**, moved that the bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favor, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that the bill entitled: "The Industrial Relations and Trade Union Act, 2024" had been read the Third Time and passed into law.





9. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members rose on SO 23:

i. The Deputy Leader II of the Opposition, Hon. Aaron Aruna Koroma from Tonkolili District rose on SO 23 and reminded the House about an issue that he raised sometimes ago concerning the increment of vehicle registration and licenses by the Sierra Leone Road Safety Authority (SLRSA) without the approval of Parliament. He informed the House that SLRSA had been subjecting people to pay the new charges for vehicular registration and licenses without the approval of Parliament. He also informed the House that SLRSA had been issuing Motor Bike Licenses instead of vehicular licenses to people that went to register their vehicles.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, asked **Hon. Aaron Aruna Koroma** to do a formal complaint about the said issue to the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Transport and Aviation to do investigation and report to the House. He stated that a copy of the formal complaint should be submitted to him.

ii. Hon. Mustapha Musa Sellu from Moyamba District rose on SO 23 and reminded the House about an issue that he had raised sometimes ago concerning the operation of two mining companies in his Chiefdom without any knowledge of their operations. He informed the House that he had complained the said issue to the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Mines and Mineral Resources but to no avail.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, asked **Hon. Mustapha M. Sellu** to submit the names of the two mining companies to the Acting Clerk of Parliament. Mr. Speaker thereby directed the Acting Clerk of Parliament to summon the two mining companies to a meeting with the Leadership of Parliament in The Speaker's Conference Room on Wednesday 5th June, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. Mr. Speaker further stated that he wanted the said issue to be handled and resolved by the Leadership.

iii. Hon. PC Kandeh Paria Kawalleh II from **Karene District** rose on SO 23 and informed the House about the scarcity of fuel in the North especially in Makeni. He pleaded with Mr. Speaker to engage the people responsible for the supply of fuel to do the needful.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, assured **Hon. PC Kandeh Paria Kawalleh II** that fuel would be available as soon as possible.





iv. The Whip of the Opposition, **Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara from Kambia District**, rose on SO 23 and informed the House about the Chieftaincy elections at Munutala Chiefdom that had not been held for the longest period now. He also informed the House that a whole section with three ruling houses had been disqualified without any detailed explanation for the said disqualification. He noted that the said act was done by the District Officer (D.O.) and Permanent Secretary (P.S.) in their vehicle, and that immediately after which they ran away.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, asked **Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara** to do a formal complaint to the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Local Government and Rural Development concerning the said issue. Mr. Speaker stated that a copy of the said formal complaint should be submitted to him as well.

Adjournment:

Mr. Speaker adjourned the House to Tuesday 4th June, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. The House rose at 4:35 p.m.
