<p><b>11:00 – 12:30 p.m.</b></p>	<p>Now, Therefore, I, <b>Julius Maada Bio</b>, President of the Republic of Sierra Leone, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice, do hereby proclaim that the First Session of the Sixth Parliament of the Second Republic of Sierra Leone shall be held at Parliament Building, Tower Hill, commencing on Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2023 at 10 O'clock in the forenoon.</p> <p>Made this 31<sup>ST</sup> day of JULY, 2023.</p> <p>Signed by His Excellency the President, <b>RTD. BRIGADIER DR. JULIUS MAADA BIO</b>".</p> <p><b>V. THE PRESIDENTIAL ADDRESS:</b></p> <p><b>HIS EXCELLENCY THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SIERRA LEONE, RTD. BRIGADIER DR.
