He said that the pathologist could not attend the meeting due to the Wellington incident. He pleaded for an extension of time. He slated a date for the joint report to be presented before Parliament which would be on Thursday, 18th November, 2021 after he was asked by the Acting Leader of Gov. Business to give a specific date.





(iii) **Hon. Mohamed Bangura of Constituency 066, Karene District** informed the House about a group of Sierra Leoneans in Germany who were about to be deported and had been calling for Help from the Government of Sierra Leone. He asked that the Minister of Foreign Affairs and International cooperation, internal affairs and immigration to be summoned by parliament to explain to Hon. Members.

The Acting Speaker, **Hon. Segepoh S. Thomas** ordered that a letter should be issued to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation and the Minister of Internal Affairs to follow up on the concern raised by the Hon. Member.
