Maada Kanja Hafiju of Constituency 018, Kenema District. It was seconded by Hon. Mohamed Kanneh of Constituency 006, Kailahun District and adopted by the House.
- 4. Laying of Papers:

The Senior Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon the Minister of Water Resources to lay the Papers that were itemized on the Order Paper.

Observation by the Whip of Opposition:

The Whip of Opposition (Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District) observed that the motion moved by Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh to debate the redenomination of the "Leones" that he himself seconded had not seen the light of day in the House, and for that he was concerned because he had received a notice from the Bank of Sierra Leone that the issuance of the new Leones would start on the 1st July 2022. He said he was deeply concerned that some processes were yet to be completed before the new Leones should be issued out.

The Leader of Government Business (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District) assured the Whip of Opposition and the House that there would be a consultative meeting in the form of a Pre-leg on Monday 27th July, 2022 between Hon. Members and Officials from the Bank of Sierra Leone. He promised that the said motion would find its way on the Order Paper on Tuesday 28th July, 2022.

5. Government Motion by the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources.

The Senior Table Clerk, Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston, called upon the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources.

The Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources, **Mr. Timothy Kabba**, presented the motion to the House and moved the ratification of it with the following words as quoted:

Continued proceedings:

7. Bill: The National Communications Authority Act, 2022 by the Minister of Information and Communications:

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Ismaila Kabba**, called upon The Minister of Information and Communications to proceed on the **Committee Stage** of the bill.

<u>Committee Stage</u> - The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

Debate continued on the amendments of the said bill.

(i) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Ismaila Kabba**, pronounced that parts 31 to 39, Clauses 157 to 195 stand part of the Bill starting from Clause 180(2).

The Deputy Minister of Information and Communications, **Solomon Jamiru Esq.**, moved that parts 31 to 39, Clauses 157 to 195 stand part of the bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate. The debate started, and some amendments were made.

The Deputy Minister of Information and Communications, **Solomon Jamiru Esq.**, again moved that parts 31 to 39, Clauses 157 to 195 stand part of the bill as amended.
