**Observation by the Whip of Opposition:**

The Whip of Opposition (**Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District**) observed that the motion moved by **Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh** to debate the redenomination of the “Leones” that he himself seconded had not seen the light of day in the House, and for that he was concerned because he had received a notice from the Bank of Sierra Leone that the issuance of the new Leones would start on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022. He said he was deeply concerned that some processes were yet to be completed before the new Leones should be issued out.

The Leader of Government Business (**Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District**) assured the Whip of Opposition and the House that there would be a consultative meeting in the form of a Pre-leg on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 between Hon. Members and Officials from the Bank of Sierra Leone. He promised that the said motion would find its way on the Order Paper on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.

**5. Government Motion by the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources.**

The Senior Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources.
