1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:15 am was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081**, **Bo District.** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Ishmail Sama Sandy of Constituency 080**, **Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 9th November, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 9th November, 2022 was moved by *Hon.Brima Mansaray of* Constituency 017, Kenema District. It was seconded by **Hon. HindoloTennyson Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Area District** and adopted by the House.

4. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) amended the Order Paper by inserting a new agenda item to be read as item iv (Laying of Paper: by the Minister of Finance) to lay The Fiscal Strategy Statement (FSS) for Financial Year (FY) 2023-2025. The motion was seconded by Hon. Christopher K. Vandy of Constituency 088, Bo District and approved by the House.

5. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that his attention had been drawn to the alarming rate of issuance of summons from Parliament to MDAs and other entities in a manner that was not in compliance with the earlier ruling of the Speaker on this important matter. He said that he was taking the opportunity to reaffirm his earlier Ruling on the matter of Summons from Parliament; and that no occasion was more propitious than that today when they had in their midst in the Chamber of Parliament a large number of senior officials of so many Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs). He said that no summon should be issued by any Committee of Parliament to any MDAs unless a copy thereof should have been duly delivered to the office of the Speaker, the Leader of Government Business and the Clerk of Parliament. He said that any Chairman together with his or her Clerk that would be in Contravention of that directive should bear the greatest responsibility for any consequences that might follow therefrom.

6. Laying of Paper:

The Senior Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon the Minister of Finance to lay the following paper that was incorporated on the amended Order Paper.

The Minister of Finance, **Mr. Dennis Vandy,** laid the following paper that was itemized on the amended Order Paper:

The Fiscal Strategy Statement (FSS) for Financial Year (FY) 2023--2025.

7. Bills:

a. The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 2022 by the Attorney-General and Minister of Justice:

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon the Attorney--General and Minister of Justice to proceed with the Second Reading of the bill.

Second Reading:

Mr. Speaker's Statement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, reminded the House that the debate on the Second Reading of the said bill had been completed long since, but on two separate sittings, the House had been unable to progress with the Second Reading by putting the question for vote because of the want of the requisite number of a vote of not less than two--thirds as stipulated in Section 108 of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone.He directed the Table Clerks to do a head count in order to ascertain the numbers of Hon. Members that were present in the Chamber. He said that in the absence of a dissenting voice, the votes cast in favour would be deemed to be the votes cast in favour of the motion, and that if there was no dissenting voice, then all Hon. Members in the Chamber would be deemed to have voted.

Mr. Speaker Put the question for Vote as quoted.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that the bill had been read the Second Time.

Committee Stage - The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that Clauses 1, 2 and 3 stand part of the bill.

The Attorney-General and Minister of Justice, **Mohamed LaminTarawally Esq.**, moved that clauses 1, 2 and 3 stand part of the bill.





Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and few constitutional amendments were made.

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, pronounced that Clause 1, 2 and 3 had formed part of the bill as amended."

The House resumed from the Committee of the Whole House.

Report Stage:

The Attorney-General and Minister of Justice, **Mohamed Lamin Tarawally Esq,** reported to the House that the Bill entitled: **"The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 2022"** had gone through Committee of the whole House with some amendments made.

Third Reading:

The Attorney-General and Minister of Justice, **Mohamed Lamin Tarawally Esq.**, moved that the Bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote as quoted.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that the bill entitled: "The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Amendment) Act, 2022." had been read the Third Time and passed into law.





b. Bill: The Appropriation Act, 2023 by the Minister of Finance.

"Being an Act to authorize expenditure from the Consolidated Fund for the services of Sierra Leone for the year 2023 and for other related matters."

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon the Minister of Finance to proceed with the Introduction and First Reading of the bill.

Introduction and First Reading:

The Minister of Finance, Mr. Dennis K. Vandi, presented the Budget Speech for 2023 to Members of Parliament and moved that the "The Appropriation Act, 2023" – (Being an Act to authorize expenditure from the Consolidated Fund for the services of Sierra Leone for the year 2023 and for other related matters) be read the First Time.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote as quoted.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that the bill had been read the First Time.

Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that by next week, the House would deal with many of the outstanding bills as awaiting and deserving the attention of the House.

He also informed the House that the debate on the 2023 Budget that had been presented to the House would commence on the 21st of November 2022, and that the five allotted days for debating the budget as prescribed by the Standing Orders would be granted but a time limit would be strictly set in order to accommodate many speakers.

8. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanation):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

Hon. Moses B. Jorkie of Constituency 091, Bonthe District informed the House that He and the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Finance had a meeting with Global Fund Country Coordinator in Sierra Leone, and that in that meeting, they were informed that Global Fund had approved \$157,196,218 in order to purchase drugs on behalf of the Government of Sierra Leone to help fighting the following diseases: HIV and AIDS, TB, Malaria as well as strengthening the health services of





the country. He said that there had been a lot of those containers that contained the said drugs parked at the Queen Elizabeth II Quay for over eight months then, and that the Ministers of Health and Finance together with the Chief Minister had made immense efforts for those drugs to be released for the benefit of the country but to no avail. He further reminded the House about an agreement between the Government of Sierra Leone during the Last administration and Global Fund.

Adjournment:

Mr. Speaker adjourned the House to Wednesday 16th November, 2022. The House rose at 12:25 p.m.
