2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 11:30 am was moved by Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Mohamed Kanneh of Constituency 006, Kailahun District and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 8th December, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Thursday 8th December, 2022** was moved by **Hon. Ishmail S. Sandy of Constituency 080, Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Kanneh of Constituency 006, Kailahun District** and adopted by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that his announcement would be a ruling, and that the said ruling should be immediately given effect by the whips on both sides of the aisle. He ruled that the Canteen of Parliament must stop selling food of any kind to Hon. Members of Parliament at 9:45 a.m. on every sitting day. He stated that if the Management of the Canteen failed to uphold his ruling, the Canteen would stand the risk of being closed permanently.
