2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

## 3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District moved a motion to amend the Order Paper that item IV(B) to now be read as item IV(A) and vice versa. Continued debate:

Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma (Leader of Government Business) 0019 Kenema
The Attorney-General and Minister of Justice, Mohamed Lamin Tarawally Esq, responded to all the issues raised by Hon. Members and again moved that the bill be read the Second Time.

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.
The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi pronounced that the bill had been read the Second Time.

## Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations)

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23
(i) Hon. Shiaka Musa Sama of Constituency 104, Pujehun District said that the laws on chieftaincy provided that town Chiefs should be elected and not appointed, but in his constituency, the town Chief was appointed and not elected and that had caused confusion among his people. He pleaded through Mr. Speaker that the laws be implemented.
(ii) Hon. Osman Wurie Jalloh of Constituency 109, Western Urban District thanked the Government and the President for the commencement of work on roads in his constituency.
(iii) Hon. Salieu Osman Sesay of Constituency 038, Bombali District said that it was exactly 2 years since the generator saga in Makeni occurred which led to the loss of lives of some people. He said a Special Committee was set up to investigate the matter but to date no report had been laid before Parliament on their findings.
