- 1. Prayers were read by Mr. Edward Sahr Lebbie (Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 10:50 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District** and approved by the House.

#### 3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District** moved a motion to amend the Order Paper that item IV(B) to now be read as item IV(A) and vice versa. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** and approved by the House.

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, said item II on the Order Paper was deliberately skipped due to technical difficulties.

- Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District, said the Votes and Proceedings had been
  coming in late of recent times and he was concerned as Whip of the Opposition. He requested through
  Mr. Speaker that the production of the document be expedited.
- The Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082** said he would engage the administrative head after the day's sitting.
- Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District informed Mr. Speaker that when the Votes and Proceedings would have been made available, Mr. Speaker should be prepared to revisit the document and make amendments if any issue arise.

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** said the concern of the Hon. Member was legitimate and it was high time Parliament went paperless in the production of its documents as that would solve those technical challenges.





### 4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that over thirty five (35) members had spoken to the Public Elections Bill that was before the House. He said that it was the largest number of members to ever speak to a particular bill. He encouraged all members to try to bring the Second Reading to a close.

### 6. Bill: The Public Elections Act, 2022 by the Attorney-General and Minister of Justice.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, called upon the Attorney-General and Minister of Justice to proceed with the Second Reading of the Bill.

Debate continued on the Second reading of the said Bill.

### **Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations)**

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23

- (i) Hon. Shiaka Musa Sama of Constituency 104, Pujehun District said that the laws on chieftaincy provided that town Chiefs should be elected and not appointed, but in his constituency, the town Chief was appointed and not elected and that had caused confusion among his people. He pleaded through Mr. Speaker that the laws be implemented.
- (ii) Hon. Osman Wurie Jalloh of Constituency 109, Western Urban District thanked the Government and the President for the commencement of work on roads in his constituency.
- (iii) Hon. Salieu Osman Sesay of Constituency 038, Bombali District said that it was exactly 2 years since the generator saga in Makeni occurred which led to the loss of lives of some people. He said a Special Committee was set up to investigate the matter but to date no report had been laid before Parliament on their findings.
