

- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:30 am was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Alice Jebbeh Kumabeh of Constituency 090, Bonthe District and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 23⁻⁻ November, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 23rd November, 2022 was moved by Hon. Habib Keifa Fabbah of Constituency 078, Bo District, it was seconded by Hon. Abu Kemokai of Constituency 103, Pujehun District and approved by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu,** referred the House to two cardinal provisions of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone which were Sections 97 and 99. He said that those two provisions crystalized and sanctified the responsibilities and privileges enjoyed by Members of Parliament. He recited the aforementioned provisions as quoted:

Section 97 - "The responsibilities of the Members of Parliament shall include the following -

- a. "All Members of Parliament shall maintain the dignity and image of Parliament both during the sittings in Parliament as well as in their acts and activities outside Parliament."
- b. "All Members of Parliament shall regard themselves as representatives of the people of Sierra Leone and desist from any conduct by which they seek improperly to enrich themselves or alienate themselves from the people." Section 99: "Subject to the provisions of this section, but without prejudice to the generality of section 97, no civil or criminal proceedings shall be instituted against a Member of Parliament in any court or place out of Parliament by reason of anything said by him in Parliament."

He said that Section 99 clearly circumscribed the limits of the privileges of Hon. Members. He stated the following as quoted: "The privileges of Hon. Members are restricted to what they say in Parliament and not what they do." He gave a notice that the conduct he observed on the 23rd November 2022 would not go unnoticed and without consequences, and that those consequences would be severe. He said that he had exercised patience beyond his endurance. He stated that the conduct on the 23rd November 2022 was an affront to the dignity of Parliament and the Office of the Speakership, and that would no longer be tolerated. He finally stated that the law would be allowed to take its consequences.





- 5. Bill: The Political Parties Act, 2022 by The Attorney--General and Minister of Justice: Committee Stage: The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.
- (i) The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that Parts 1 to 5; Clauses 1 to 20 stand part of the bill.

The Deputy Attorney--General and Minister of Justice, **Umar Napoleon Koroma Esq**, moved that Parts 1 to 5; Clauses 1 to 20 stand part of the bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and some amendments were made.

The Deputy Attorney--General and Minister of Justice, **Umar Napoleon Koroma Esq**, again moved that Parts 1 to 5; Clauses 1 to 20 stand part of the bill as amended.

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favor, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Price Oviasuyi, pronounced that Parts 1 to 5; Clauses 1 to 20 had formed part of the bill as amended.

(ii) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 6 to 10; Clauses 21 to 46 including the Schedules stand part of the bill.

The Deputy Attorney--General and Minister of Justice, **Umar Napoleon Koroma Esq**, moved that Parts 6 to 10; Clauses 21 to 46 including the Schedules stand part of the bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and some amendments were made.

The Deputy Attorney--General and Minister of Justice, **Umar Napoleon Koroma Esq**, again moved that Parts 6 to 10; Clauses 21 to 46 including the Schediles stand part of the bill as amended.





Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favor, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Price Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 6 to 10; Clauses 21 to 46 including the Schedules had formed part of the bill as amended.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

Report Stage:

The Deputy Attorney--General and Minister of Justice, **Umar Napoleon Koroma Esq,** reported to the House that the bill entitled: **"The Political Parties Act, 2022"** had gone through the Committee of the Whole with some amendments made.

Third Reading:

The Deputy Attorney--General and Minister of Justice, **Umar Napoleon Koroma Esq**, moved that the bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that the bill entitled: "The Political Parties Act, 2022" had been read the Third Time and passed into law.

Standing Order 71 (Special Select Committee):

The Chairman of the Special Select Committee established to investigate the issue of fake certificates and degrees in Sierra Leone, **Hon. Dr. Alhaji Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella**, updated the House about the status of the Committee, its engagements with various stakeholders within the education sector together with student unions of different educational institutions. He informed the House that the report of the Special Select Committee would be laid on the Table of the House in January 2023.





Standing Order 34 (Raising of Point of Order):

The Deputy Speaker, **Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas**, rose on a point of order and stated that the update by **Hon. Dr. Yumkella** was not necessary at the particular moment because the said Committee had been charged with the responsibility to do the needful investigations and bring forth a report upon which a debate should be ensured. He also noted that the Committee's request for Hon. Members to submit their qualifications was superfluous because that was not a requirement for becoming a Member of Parliament as stipulated by Section 75 of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone. He said that there was no file for Hon. Members in Parliament, and none of them declared their qualifications.

Document Read and Submitted by The Clerk of Parliament:

The Clerk of Parliament, Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally, read and submitted a document that contained the "Report of November 23rd Attack on the Chamber of Parliament." Please see attachment at the end of this document.

After The Clerk of Parliament had read and submitted "The Report of November 23rd Attack on the Chamber of Parliament, The Deputy Speaker, Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas, insisted that Mr. Speaker should invoke S.O. 43 (3). He therefore moved a motion.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The RT. Hon. **Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu,** pleaded with **Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas** to hold his motion in abeyance. He noted that he had received the report from the Clerk of Parliament, but he wanted to take his time to study the report. He informed the House that by the next adjourned date, the House would receive his reactions and decisions accordingly.

Standing Order 5 (Sittings):

The Leader of Government Business (**Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma**) rose on S.O. 5 (1) and moved a motion for the House to meet on Monday 28th of November 2022 in order to commence the debate on the budget speech that would last for five consecutive days as it had been ruled by Mr. Speaker. The Motion was seconded by the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Finance (**Hon. Francis A. Kaisamba**) and approved by the House.

6. Adjournment:

Mr. Speaker adjourned the House to Monday 28th November, 2022. The House rose at 4:45 p.m.
