- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata B. Weston (Senior Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2) at 10:20 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:35 a.m. was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Sahr Charles of Constituency 028, Kono District and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2022:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, differed the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings due to some technical reasons.

The Leader of The National Grand Coalition (NGC), **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella**, rose on S.O. 19 and 20 and gave a notice of motion for the House to invite the Minister of Political and Public Affairs as well as the Chief Electoral Commissioner for the Electoral Commission of Sierra Leone (ECSL) to discuss the Proportional Representation (PR) System of elections. He stated that he had moved the said "Notice of Motion" in his capacity as Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Political and Public Affairs.

### Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, admonished **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella** to do the needful thing in relation to his notice of motion as stipulated by Standing Order 22.

### 4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that the rumour of the heavy presence of security personnel on the precincts of Parliament was unfounded as he had ascertained that they were not more than the ordinary. He stated that he had been reliably informed by the relevant authorities that the police officers on the precincts of Parliament were on orientation duties. He said the House was working towards having its own autonomous security forces, but as presently as it was, they had to depend on the Sierra Leone Police (SLP) for security.

### 5. Government Motion by the Minister of Finance:

The Senior Table Clerk, Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston, called upon the Minister of Finance.

The Deputy Minister I of Finance, **Mr. Sheku Ahmed Fantamadi Bangura**, presented the motion to the House and moved the ratification of it with the following words as quoted:

"Be it resolved: That This Honourable House hereby ratifies the following agreement which was laid on the Table of the House on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2022."





During the presentation of the Government Motion by the Deputy Minister I of Finance, **Hon. Lahai Marah of Constituency 042, Falaba District** interjected and submitted that the loan agreement should be dealt with separately for ratification from the two other agreements within the said Government Motion.
