3. The Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 27th July, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 27th July, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Habib Keifa Fabbah of Constituency 078, Bo District**. It was seconded by **Hon. James Ozan Tholley of Constituency 054, Tonkolili District** and adopted by the House.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, thanked all Hon. Members for their cooperation and collaboration during the passage of the **"Public Elections Bill"**. He described the bill as a marathon because it took over two weeks of deliberation; all geared towards having a law that would stand the test of time and help concretize and deepen democracy. He said the law would help make elections in the country more credible and generally acceptable.

Mr. Speaker also acknowledged the presence of His Excellency, The Ambassador of the Republic of Cuba and then announced the Membership of Sierra Leone-Cuba Friendship Corps Parliamentary Caucus;

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District** moved a motion that the proposed Sierra Leone-Cuba Friendship Corps Parliamentary Caucus be approved. The motion was seconded by **Hon. James Ozan Tholley of Constituency 054, Tonkolili District** and approved by the House.

- 5. Bill:
- (A) The National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2022 by the Minister of Environment

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon The Minister of Environment to proceed on the **<u>Committee Stage</u>** of the bill.

<u>Committee Stage</u> - The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

Presentation of Report:

The Chairman of the Legislative Committee, **Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Constituency 130, Western Urban District,** presented a Report of the Legislative Committee on the consultative meeting held with the Ministry of Environment and the National Protected Area Authority.

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, temporarily Put a halt to the proceedings and asked all Hon. Members to rise and observe a minute's silence in memory of the spouse of **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella.** He recited the following prayer as quoted **"May Allah Almighty forgive her mistakes on earth and grant her gentle soul eternal rest in His heavenly kingdom, Amen."**

Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella of Constituency 069, Kambia District thanked Mr. Speaker, the Leadership of Parliament and his colleague Hon. Members for their support during his time of grief. He thanked them immensely for their solidarity and prayers for himself and his family.

Debate continued on the amendments of the said bill starting from Clause 23.

The Minister of Environment, **Prof. Foday Jaward**, moved that Parts 5, 6 and 7, Clauses 19 to 33 stand part of the bill as amended.





Mr. Chairman put the question for vote. "All those in favour, say Aye." "All those against, say Nay." Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, pronounced that Parts 5, 6, and 7, Clauses 19 to 33 had formed part of the bill as amended.

The House resumed from Committee of the Whole House.

Report Stage:

The Minister of Environment, **Prof. Foday Jaward**, reported to the House that the bill entitled "**The National Protected Area Authority Act, 2022**" had gone through the Committee of the Whole House with some amendments made.

Third Reading:

The Minister of Environment, **Prof. Foday Jaward**, moved that the Bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote. "All those in favour, say Aye." "All those against, say Nay." Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, pronounced that the bill entitled: **"The National Protected Area Authority Act, 2022"** had been read the Third Time and passed into law.

(B) Bill: The Local Government Act, 2021 by the Minister of Local Government.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon **the Minister of Local Government** to proceed with the **Introduction and First Reading** of the Bill.





(i) Introduction and First Reading:

The Minister of Local Government and Rural Development, **Mrs. Melrose Karminty** moved that the bill entitled **"The Local Government Act, 2021"** be read the **<u>First Time</u>**.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote. "All those in favour, say Aye." "All those against, say Nay." Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that the bill had been read the First Time.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon the Minister of Local Government to proceed with the **Second Reading** of the said bill.

(ii) Second Reading:

The Minister of Local Government and Rural Development, **Mrs. Melrose Karminty**, moved that the bill entitled **"The Local Government Act, 2021"** be read the <u>Second Time</u>. He presented the objects and reasons of the bill to the House and again moved that the bill be read the <u>Second Time</u>.

Mr. Speaker proposed the question for debate.
